 - What criteria should the Council use in resolving tensions between regional goals and policies that are sometimes forced to compete for limited resources? (i.e. environmental stewardship and regional development, commercial development and affordable housing, etc.)
 - What advice do you have for Metropolitan Council members as the Council moves ahead on developing the Thrive MSP 2040 plans?
