BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: Since Minnesota received extra federal funds because no new transportation act has been passed and no high priority projects (HPP) were added, the TAB elected to distribute available formula funds to all seven counties using the 2010 State Aid allocation. Each county has selected projects that can be delivered in Fiscal Year 2011 that have no right-of-way impacts or require environmental review. This project satisfies these requirements.

#### PROJECT BACKGROUND:

Minnesota is forecasted to receive an estimated \$95 million of additional federal funds for federal fiscal year 2011 because no new authorization act has been signed. Of that \$95 million, Metro District will receive \$38.5 million. Of the \$38.5 million, \$12 million will go to the locals and \$26.5 will go to Mn/DOT trunk highway pavement projects. The \$12 million will be divided between the eight metro counties. Distribution of these funds to each county is based on formula used to distribute the 2010 State Aid allocation. For Scott County, the federal amount received is \$883,050.

Scott County has identified a pavement rehabilitation project, project 070-642-023, to utilize the additional federal funds. The project includes:

- Pavement rehabilitation Roadway and Trail
- Upgrade all pedestrian ramps to ADA standards
- Install durable pavement markings, including crosswalks
- Minor drainage improvements adding one catch basin

This amendment is needed to add this project in SFY 2011 and 2011-2014.
