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PROJECT BACKGROUND:

1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g., project in previous STIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in STIP).

Annually Congress approves an Appropriation Bill that includes funds for specific projects. The 2010 Appropriation Bill was recently passed and signed by the President. Funds should be coming to Minnesota in the near future and the project proposer has indicated they would like to utilize the funds in early SFY 2011. This amendment is needed to add the Lowry Ave Bridge project that has received 2010 Appropriation earmark funds to the current STIP. This amount is only a portion of the total project.

Also, there are two funding lines in the current STIP. One identifies the 2009 Appropriation amount (Seq. # 1431) and the second identifies the Stimulus Funds that were determined to be ineligible for the County to use. An administrative modification has been submitted to change this amount to reflect the Counties portion of the project amount for Phase II and the 2009 Appropriation only.

Below is a summary of funding for Lowry Ave. Bridge Phase II:
