#### PROJECT BACKGROUND:

This amendment is needed to add the Interstate 94 / Brockton Lane Interchange – Preliminary Engineering project to the current TIP in SFY 2010.

Recently, the FFY 2010 Federal Consolidated Appropriation Act was enacted on December 16, 2009 (H.R. 3288). This project was identified to receive \$800,000 as part of the 2010 Federal Transportation Appropriations Bill under the Interstate Maintenance Discretionary (IMD) Program. This program requires a 10% local math.
