That the Metropolitan Council concur with the attached Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include the following six projects (identified in the table) that were included in the 2010 Federal Appropriations Bill.

1. Northstar Corridor Construction & Start up FTA = \$711,661, Other = \$711,661 Total = \$1,423,322

2. Grand Rounds National Scenic Byway Missing Link Phase 1 design, acquisition, environmental remediation, construction
Earmark/Total = \$500,000

3. Hastings Bridge/Highway 61 R/W and construction Earmark/Total = \$486,917
