PROJECT BACKGROUND:

1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g., project in previous STIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in STIP).

Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority (RCRRA) applied for \$135.7 million in Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant funds in September 2010 and was awarded a \$35 million grant on February 18, 2010. The funds will be applied for construction of the Union Depot train deck, including its tracks, drives and platforms. The grant is available through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and will be administered by Metropolitan Council. FTA staff has requested that RCRRA submit a project application to receive the funds by May 7, 2010. Environmental work for the project is nearing completion and it is expected that FTA and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will sign off on the Environmental Assessment in the next week, clearing the way for construction to begin later this summer.
