Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to adopt an amendment to the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that splits the Maplewood Mall Transit Center expansion and service improvements over two years, advancing the \$4,129,070 park and ride construction from program year 2013 to 2011 and maintaining the balance of the award (\$3,010,930) for bus purchases and expanded bus service in the original program year of 2013.

Background

This project was awarded federal Congestion Management Air Quality (CMAQ) funds in the regional solicitation. Metro Transit is proposing changes to the timing of the project to allow earlier construction of the transit center and the associated ramp parking as usage of the current facility is over capacity. However, the buses and additional service will not be needed until the expansion of the parking facility is completed.

Rationale

In order to spend federal transportation funds, the projects must be recorded in the proper year of the current TIP.

Funding

The amendment allowing the transit center and parking to be completed earlier is possible since other unrelated projects have been deferred for a variety of reasons, freeing up CMAQ funds for 2011 use on this project. Total funding does not change.

No opposition was presented at TAC or TAB.

Ms. Haigh,

On March 16, 2011, the Transportation Advisory Board voted to amend the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program to split the CMAQ-funded Maplewood Mall Transit Center expansion and advance the \$4,129,070 park and ride construction portion of the Maplewood Mall Transit Center from program year 2013 to 2011 and maintain the balance of the original CMAQ award (\$3,010,930) for bus purchases and bus service in 2013.

Metro Transit requested this amendment to advance the park and ride construction element of the combined project so it could be completed before purchasing the buses and implementing the expanded service.

The TAB forwards the TIP amendment action to the Metropolitan Council along with additional information described in TAB action transmittal 2011-30.

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: Construction of the Maplewood Mall Transit Center expansion in 2012 instead of 2013 is important because the existing facility has been over capacity, often overflowing into unauthorized areas of the adjacent shopping center property. The parking structure expansion will help meet current and projected demand. This TIP amendment is just splitting an existing project into two parts and does not affect fiscal constraint or air quality. Additional background material is attached.

- 2) Maintain balance of \$3,010,930 (\$7,140,000 minus \$4,129,070 advanced in part 1 of this request) Federal CMAQ funds for bus purchase and bus service for 2013

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

- 1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g., project in previous TIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in TIP).
 - Advancement of CMAQ money for the facility portion of the Maplewood expansion project into SFY 2011 will allow time for a grant to be in place for execution of a construction contract in 2012. Construction of the Maplewood Mall Transit Center expansion in 2012 instead of 2013 is important because the existing facility has been over capacity, often overflowing into unauthorized areas of the adjacent shopping center property. The parking structure expansion will help meet current and projected demand. Construction of the park and ride in 2012 will also allow completion of the facility so it is ready for new buses and operation by 2013.
 - Advance \$4,129,070 Federal CMAQ Park and Ride construction portion of Maplewood Mall Transit Center expansion from 2013 to 2011

Metro Transit was awarded \$7,140,000 Federal for expansion of the park & ride, bus purchase and service for 2013. The portion identified for park and ride construction is \$4,129,070 Federal. Early access to a portion of the park and ride facility construction CMAQ funds helps fill the gap in funding for construction to begin in 2012, and will allow completion of the facility so it is ready for new buses and operation by 2013.

- 2) Maintain balance of \$3,010,930 (\$7,140,000 minus \$4,129,070 advanced in 2b of this request) Federal CMAQ funds for Maplewood Mall Transit Center bus purchase and bus service for 2013
- 2. The existing project line in the TIP for project CMT-09-07 identified in SFY 2013 of the 2011-2014 TIP will be reduced by \$4,129,070 federal. This amended line in the TIP will show the remaining balance bus purchase and service to the facility as \$3,010,930 federal funds, \$752,733 local/Metro Transit funds and \$3,763,663 total cost. Keel/TIP amendment February 10, 2011

A request by Metro Transit to extend the Sunset Date for Project TRS-TCMT-10B, Purchase 6 Artic. Buses for RTE 673 at the CR 73 park and ride, from SFY 2011 to SFY 2012 has been approved by the Funding and Programming Committee on January 20, 2011 and the Technical Advisory Committee on February 2, 2011. This deferral will make available in SFY 2011 \$2,722,080 of the \$4,129,070 federal funds needed to advance project CMT-09-07-Expansion of Maplewood Mall Transit Center. After the Metro State Aid Program Review, two additional projects have been deferred to SFY 2012 making available in SFY 2011 \$1,439,640. These projects are:

- SP 107-090-006, City of Bloomington, Seq. # 1431, Ped/Bike Bridge over Killebrew Dr., \$1,008,000 federal dollars
- SP 082-622-008, Washington County, Seq. #1412, CSAH 22 at Hardwood Ave., \$431,640 federal dollars

The total deferral amount from all three projects is \$4,161,720 Federal dollars. Fiscal constraint is maintained by the deferral of these three projects, allowing \$4,129,070 of project CMT-09-07 to move from SFY 2013 to SFY 2011.
