Metropolitan Airports Commission Roles

- Minnesota Statutes 473.601-473.679
- Promote Aviation & Competitive Air Service
- Owns & Operates 7 Public Airports in Metro Area
- Prepares Airport Long-Term Comprehensive Plans
- Annually prepares CIP to implement planned improvements



Met Council Aviation Planning Roles

- Minnesota Statute 473.621
- Prepare Metropolitan Aviation System Plan
- Review Metro Airport & community comprehensive plans, environmental evaluations
- Review the MAC Capital Improvement Program (CIP)



Legislative Requirements CIP Review

- MS 473.621 Subd. 6
- Public participation process in the CIP process
- Council reviews all projects
- Approve projects with potential of significant effect on regional development
 - Minneapolis St. Paul International Airport (MSP) greater than \$5,000,000.
 - Reliever Airports greater than \$2,000,000.
 - Significant effect criteria in legislation



2012 Findings

- Adequate public participation process
- Assessment of Environmental Effects (AOEE)
- CIP identifies adequate funding
- CIP is consistent with 2030 TPP
- One project that requires approval:
 - Checked Baggage Inspection System (CBIS)
