Existing state statute 473.1466 requires that:


"Prior to each major revisions of the Transportation Policy Plan, the Council must carry out a performance evaluation of the metropolitan area's transportation system as a whole."


Requirements


Metropolitan Council

The performance evaluation must:

- Evaluate ability of the system to meet the need for effective and efficient transportation of goods and people;
- Evaluate trends and impacts on the transportation system;
- Assess the region's success in meeting adopted benchmarks;
- Evaluate the regional transit system with comparisons to peer regions.









Results

- 2014 Transportation Policy Plan update will include performance measures based on plan goals and objectives
- Measures should be:
 - Quantifiable, based on available data
 - Developed through consensus among partners (MnDOT, MAC, Counties, CTIB, etc.)
 - Realistic (if targets are established)
- Establish an on-going measurement and monitoring plan to track progress
