Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include SP#164-070-025: Nice Ride Expansion at the St Paul Capitol Complex and State Offices.

Background

This amendment is needed to be able to authorize \$100,000 in federal funds from the MnDOT Destination Innovation Program administered by the Commissioners Opportunity Fund for the purpose of installing Nice Ride kiosks at the Capitol Complex and at other state office buildings.

Rationale

The Transportation Advisory Board approves formal amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program. The Metropolitan Council concurs with the action of the TAB. This project and the amendment is exempt from air quality conformity analysis, is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan and does not affect fiscal constraint as it adds federal funds available from the Commissioners Opportunity Fund.

Funding

This project will be funded with a combination of funds from the Commissioner's Opportunity Fund which is controlled by MnDOT as well as \$90,000 in state funds from the Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) Department plus a private match of \$95,000 from Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Minnesota.

Known Support / Opposition

There was no opposition expressed. The amendment is supported by MnDOT, MMB and Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Minnesota.

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: This project will receive \$100,000 from the MnDOT Commissioner's opportunity fund with a total match of \$185,000 from the Minnesota Management and Budget Department and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota. These funds will be used to provide Nice Ride kiosks in the Capitol Complex and State office buildings. The project is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan, is exempt from air quality conformity analysis and uses new federal funds. Additional background material is attached.

RELATIONSHIP TO REGIONAL POLICY: Federal law requires that all transportation projects that will be partially funded with federal funds must be in an approved Transportation Improvement Program and meet the following four tests: fiscal constraint; consistency with the adopted regional transportation plan; air quality conformity and opportunity for public input. It is the TAB's responsibility to adopt and amend the TIP according to these four requirements.

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

 Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g. project in previous TIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in TIP).

This amendment is needed to add Project 164-070-025 to SFY 2012 of the 2012-2015 STIP. On January 19, 2012 the Transportation Program Investment Committee approved \$100,000 of Federal Funds from the Mn/DOT Destination Innovation program for the Bike Share-Nice Ride and Bicycle Pools project to expand Nice Ride Minnesota into St. Paul. Nice Ride Kiosks will be placed on the Capital Complex and other state office buildings, destinations downtown St. Paul and along the Mississippi River. State employees and the general public will be able to use the bikes to travel to their destination instead of driving single occupancy vehicles. The expansion is part of a larger system that will include expansion along the Mississippi River through the National Park Service. The Mn/DOT Commissioner's opportunity fund is the source of the federal funds; the state funds are from the Minnesota Management and Budget Department and the private match is being provided by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota.

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^{*} The \$100,000 in federal funds needed for this project are available from the Commissioners Opportunity Fund, Project 880C-COF-12 (Seq #2173) which has a total of \$1,570,000 in federal funds available. After the take down of \$100,000 dollars for this project, there will be \$1,470,000 funds remaining in Project 880C-COF-12 for future projects. The \$90,000 in State Funds match funds for this project are being provided by the Minnesota Management and Budget Department and the \$95,000 in Private funds are being provided by Blue Cross and Blue

Shield of Minnesota. These Federal, State and Private funds are sufficient to cover the total cost of the project therefore fiscal constraint is maintained.
