## Business Impacts Supplemental EIS



- Prepared in response to District Court order issued January 23, 2012
- Analyzes potential impacts to business revenues caused by CCLRT Project
- Relies largely on local data
  - Wilder Foundation survey
  - St. Paul Business Support Fund
  - CCPO business census
