Regular Business

- Develop and approve 2009 Community Development Division annual budget.
- Monitor status of 2008 comprehensive planning updates.
- Review and develop recommendations on Comprehensive Plan Updates, Amendments, and other Statuterequired reviews.
- Prepare annual reports, including Agriculture Preserves, Metropolitan Livable Communities Fund (to legislature), and 2007 Plat Monitoring Report.
- Review and recommend the LCA Annual Fund Distribution Plan.
- Review and develop recommendations for Livable Communities Act grants.
- Monitor Livable Communities Act Fund administration.
- Monitor Parks Master Plan implementation reviews.
- Review and approve Public Housing Plan, Section 8 Administrative Plan and Public Housing Admissions and Continued Occupancy Plan, Management Operations Certification (MASS/PHAS) - FAHP, Payment Standards and Utility Allowance Schedule, and project-based assistance contract awards.
- Review performance indicators for Community Development Division.

- Review and assist Regional Park Foundation initiative.
- Consider recommendations of the LCDA work group to focus LCA Livable Communities Demonstration Account grants awarded in 2008 on new opportunities for innovation and demonstration.
- Consider the findings of the Diversified Rural Area work group and staff recommendations regarding strengthened implementation steps to preserve land in the Long-Term Service Area.
