Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council extends City of Chaska's comprehensive plan update submission deadline from December 31, 2008 to August 31, 2009.

Background

Minnesota Statutes section 473.864 requires all local governments in the seven-county metropolitan area to review and update their local comprehensive plans submit those updates to the Metropolitan Council for review and comment by December 31, 2008. Section 473.864 authorizes the Council to grant extensions to local government units if they need additional time to complete their comprehensive plan review and revisions. According to statute, any extensions granted by the Council "must include a timetable for completion of the review." The Metropolitan Land Planning Act requires the Council to establish guidelines and procedures to which local government units must conform when preparing, adopting, and submitting their plans. In June, the Council adopted guidelines and procedures for communities to follow when requesting extensions to the comprehensive plan update submission deadline.

Pursuant to the guidelines adopted by the Metropolitan Council on June 25, 2008, the City of Chaska has submitted the required materials to request an extension to the statutory submission date for comprehensive plan updates. The City has requested that their submission date be extended from December 31, 2008, to August 31, 2009.

In the request materials, the City explains that comprehensive plan update has been delayed primarily because the City was awaiting a decision by MnDOT as to the location of the proposed new TH41 bridge. The new bridge is not expected to be built before 2030. It is expected to be 4-lane bridge replacing the current 2-lane TH41 bridge that is located on the south side of downtown Chaska. MnDOT has analyzed several alternative locations, all of which will have the potential for significant impacts in Chaska with respect to transportation, land use, and open space elements of the City's plan, and which may also impact sewer and water and other plan elements. That decision has still not been made and the City has decided that it will have to revisit the plan once the decision is made. The City indicates that the draft of the comprehensive plan will be complete in early December 2008, with the adjacent community and affected jurisdiction review being initiated by December 10, 2008. The 6-month review period would then be complete in mid-June, allowing the community time to make any necessary changes and the City Council to take action to submit the plan to the Council by August 31, 2009.

Rationale

Anticipating that some communities may encounter issues in completing and submitting their plans by the statutory December 31, 2008 submission date, the Council adopted a process and guidelines that allow for the extension of the submission date. Requests for extensions up to May 29, 2009 may be administratively reviewed and granted, while requests for extensions to a date beyond May 29, 2009 require Council action.

The City's request for an extension to August 31, 2009 is three months beyond that which could be administratively reviewed to accommodate a full six-month adjacent review period. It has been Council staff's experience that many communities have been able to obtain comments from the affected jurisdictions prior to the termination of the full six months.

Funding

No Metropolitan Council funding involved. The City did not receive a comprehensive planning grant or loan.

There is no known opposition.

Dear Councilmembers:

The Metropolitan Land Planning Act requires that all local governmental units have their 2030 Comprehensive Plan updates submitted to the Metropolitan Council by December 31, 2008. The City of Chaska will have its plan updated and approved by the local community by that date. However, state law requires a six-month adjacent community and special district review prior to formal submittal of the plan to the Metropolitan Council. Therefore, the City needs to request and extension to allow for that six-month adjacent community review and for the City to consider and act on any comments received during that process.

The reason for the extension request stems from a decision the City expected to receive from the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT). MnDOT was to select a location for a new river crossing of Trunk Highway 41 over the Minnesota River in December of 2007. All of the alternates for the new river crossing greatly impact the future land use decisions within the City of Chaska. MnDOT has yet to select this river crossing, which caused a large delay in the commencement of the update effort. Therefore the City had no other choice but to proceed with its Comprehensive Plan update without this important decision informing the future land use choices in this update.

At its October 6, 2008, meeting, the Chaska City Council adopted a resolution, finding it appropriate to request from the Metropolitan Council an extension so the City can have additional time to complete and submit to the Metropolitan Council for review an updated comprehensive plan and amend its fiscal devices and official controls.

The City anticipates that the Comprehensive Plan update will be completed by the City and available for review by December 31, 2008, but the six-month adjacent community review and City review and action on any comments would push the ultimate submittal date to August 31, 2009.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes section 473.864 requires local governmental units to review and, if necessary, amend their entire comprehensive plans and their fiscal devices and official controls at least once every ten years to ensure comprehensive plans conform with metropolitan system plans and ensure fiscal devices and official controls do not conflict with comprehensive plans or permit activities that conflict with metropolitan system plans; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes sections 473.858 and 473.864 require local governmental units to complete their "decennial" reviews by December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes section 473.864 authorizes the Metropolitan Council to grant extensions to local governmental units to allow local governmental units additional time within which to complete the "decennial" review and amendments; and

WHEREAS, any extensions granted by the Metropolitan Council must include a timetable and plan for completing the review and amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chaska will not be able to complete its "decennial" review by December 31, 2008, for the following reasons: The State of Minnesota — Department of Transportation (MnDOT) was to select a location for a new river crossing of Trunk Highway 41 over the Minnesota River in December of 2007 and all of the alternates for the new river crossing greatly impact the future land use decisions within the City of Chaska; and

WHEREAS, MnDOT, as of this date, has yet to select this river crossing, which caused a large delay in the commencement of the update effort and the City had no other choice but to proceed with its Comprehensive Plan update without this important decision informing the future land use choices in this update; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is appropriate to request from the Metropolitan Council an extension so the City can have additional time to complete and submit to the Metropolitan Council for review an updated comprehensive plan and amend its fiscal devices and official controls; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates that the Comprehensive Plan update will be completed by the City and available for review by December 31, 2008, but the six-month adjacent community review and City review and action on any comments would push the ultimate adoption past May 29, 2009; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Chaska, Minnesota, hereby adopts Resolution #08-69, as follows:

- 1. The City Administrator is directed to submit to the Metropolitan Council no later than November 1, 2008, an application requesting an extension to August 31, 2009.
- 2. The City Administrator shall include with the request a reasonably detailed timetable and plan for completing: (a) the review and amendment by August 31, 2009; and (b) the review and amendment of the City's fiscal devices and official controls.
