Proposed Action/Motion

That the Regional Administrator be authorized to execute contracts for up to \$1,799,876 for a SouthWest Transit garage expansion and up to \$1,704,496 for a Plymouth park-and-ride facility.

Overview and Funding

The Council approves funding for capital spending and must give contract authority separate from funding approval. This action provides the legal authority to execute contracts for previously approved capital projects in the 2007 CIP.

- The March Amendment to the 2007-2012 CIP, Item 2007-66, reallocated \$299,876 to an existing garage expansion project by Southwest Transit. The project had some unforeseen cost overruns that this additional money will cover. Additional funding for this project comes from canceled or under spent projects previously allocated to SouthWest.
- The March Amendment to the 2007-2012 CIP, Item 2007-66, reallocated \$19,921 to a Plymouth parkand-ride project that along County Road 73. The project had some unforeseen cost overruns that were originally absorbed by the city of Plymouth and this additional money will cover those overruns. Additional funding for this project comes from a canceled bus equipment project for Plymouth.
- These projects are identified in the approved CIP with the first quarter 2007.
