Proposed Action/Motion

- 1 That the Metropolitan Council, as required by Mn. Statute 473.166, approve a request by MnDOT to reconstruct Trunk Highway (TH) 65 between 121st Avenue/Paul Parkway and 129th Avenue in Blaine as shown on the attached map.
- 2 That any significant changes in the design of the proposed project are subject to further review and approval by the Metropolitan Council prior to construction.

Overview, Issue(s) and Funding

The purpose of this project is to improve capacity, reduce the number of direct access points and improve safety at the intersection of TH 65 and TH 242/CSAH 14. The intersection of TH 65 and TH 242/CSAH 14 is one of the most congested and dangerous in Minnesota. Major components of the project are a single-point urban interchange at TH 242/CSAH 14; grade separation of TH 65 at 121st Avenue/Paul Parkway and at 129th Avenue. On TH 65, the southbound shoulder lanes and northbound auxiliary lanes will accommodate buses.

Reconstruction of the TH 65/TH 242 interchange is consistent with the Metropolitan Council's transportation policy plan and is shown in the 2007-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Estimated total project cost is \$30 million. Federal Surface Transportation Project (STP) funding was secured through the Transportation Advisory Board's regional solicitation and state funds came from the 2004 highway bond program. Project construction is scheduled to begin in July 2007 and is anticipated to end in the fall of 2009.
