### Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to issue purchase orders to the following companies: Hawkins Chemicals, Inc. for the procurement of Chlorine (1-Ton Cylinders) and Ferric Chloride; DPC Industries for Sodium Hypochlorite (Bleach) and Liquid Sulfur Dioxide (1-Ton Cylinders); K.A. Steel Chemicals, Inc. for Sodium Hydroxide Solution (Caustic Soda); C&S Chemicals, Inc. for Aluminum Sulfate; and PVS Chemical Solutions, Inc. for Sodium Bisulfate.

### Issue(s)

- Procurement of goods and services for amounts exceeding \$250,000 requires Council approval.

### Overview and Funding

Bids were solicited to supply several process chemicals for MCES facilities for a two year period. A formal Invitation for Bids was issued and responses were obtained from seven (7) potential suppliers of which 5 were successful. Responders were able to bid on one or all chemicals. The lowest responsive, responsible bidders were as follows:

Hawkins, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Chlorine (1-Ton Cylinders) and Ferric Chloride.

DPC Industries was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Bleach and Liquid Sulfur Dioxide.

K.A.Steel Chemicals, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Sodium Hydroxide Solution (Caustic Soda).

C & S Chemicals, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Aluminum Sulfate.

PVS Chemical Solutions, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Sodium Bisulfate.

The purchase orders will be for a period of two years.

Estimated expenditures for these process chemicals are \$2,850,000 over the two-year period. Funds are available through the annual operating budget of each facility utilizing the chemicals.
