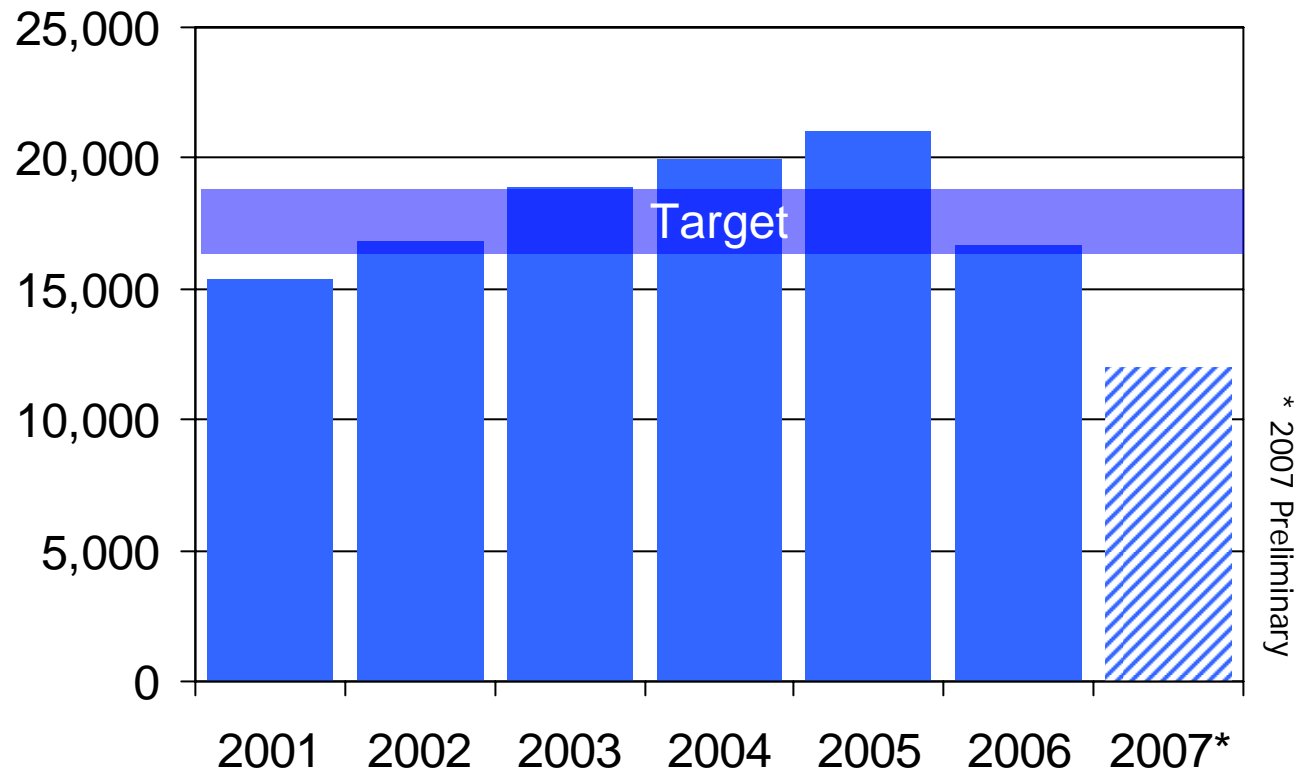

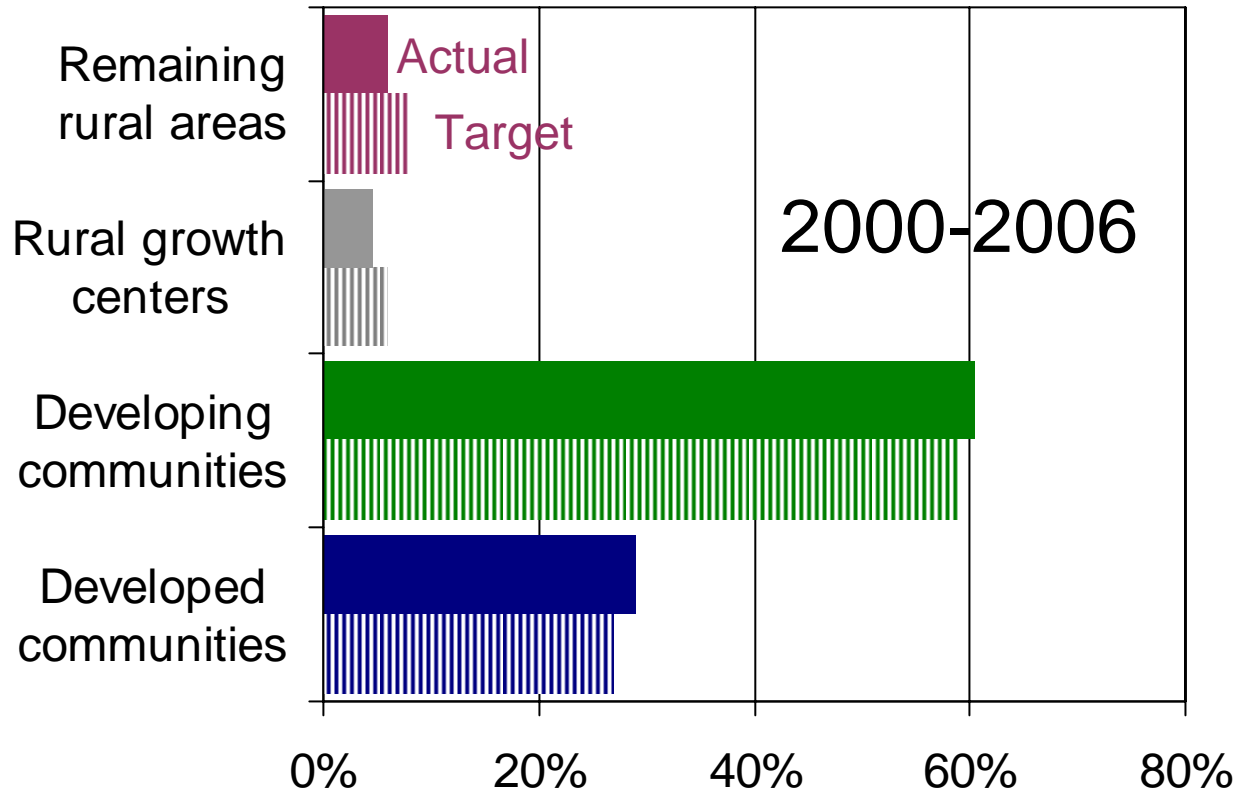

Accommodating growth: Housing location

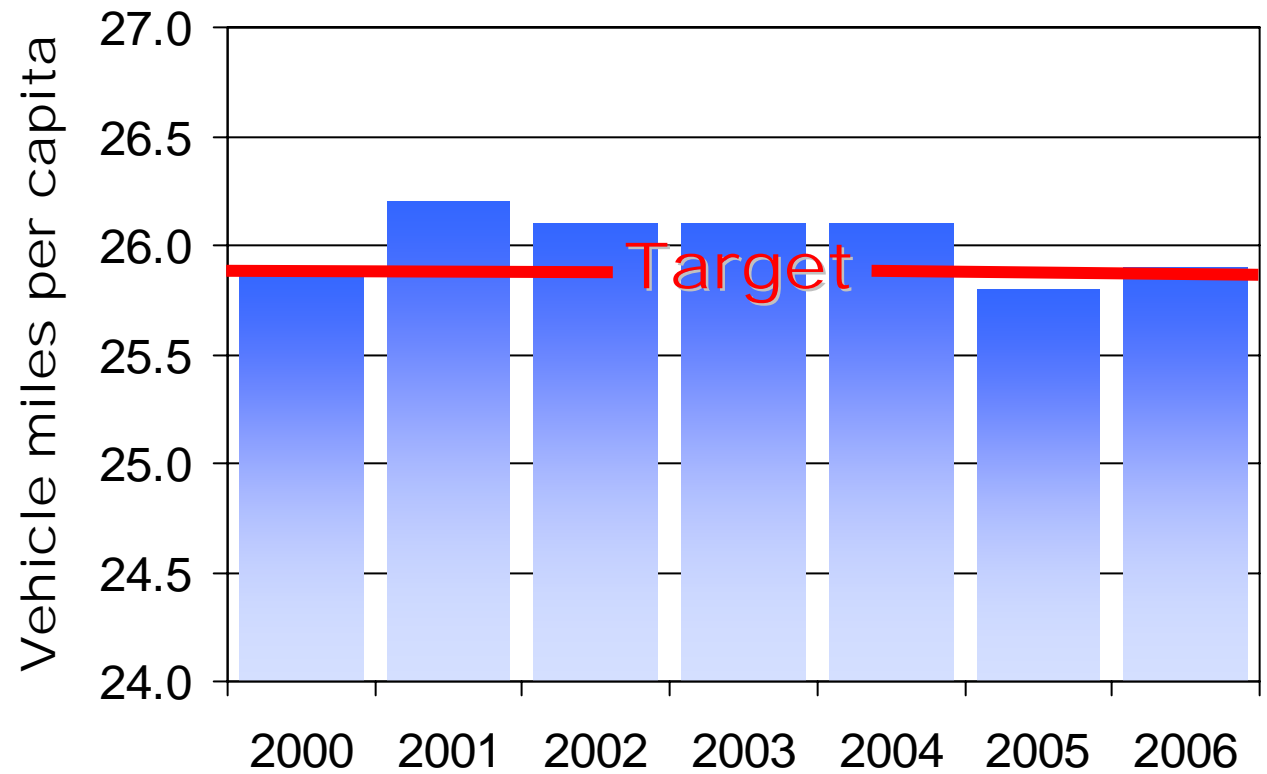

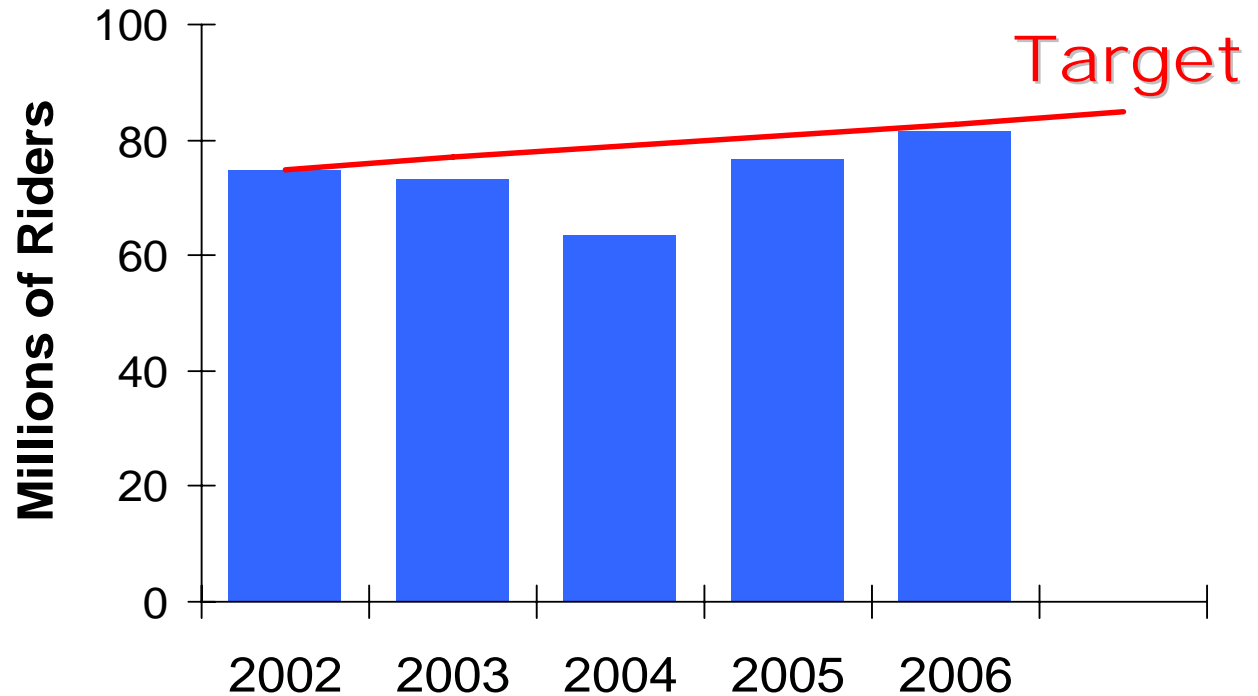
- Target: 50%

Transportation: Daily roadway use

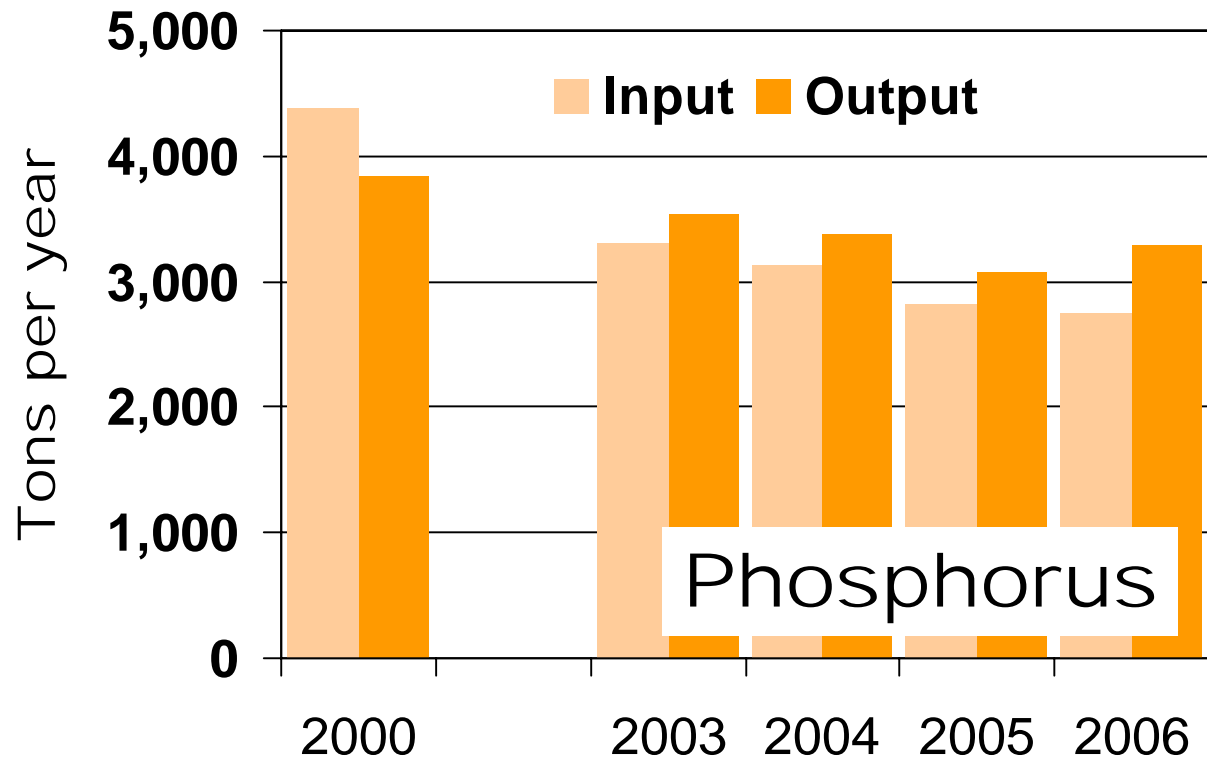


Transportation: Transit ridership

(3% annual growth)

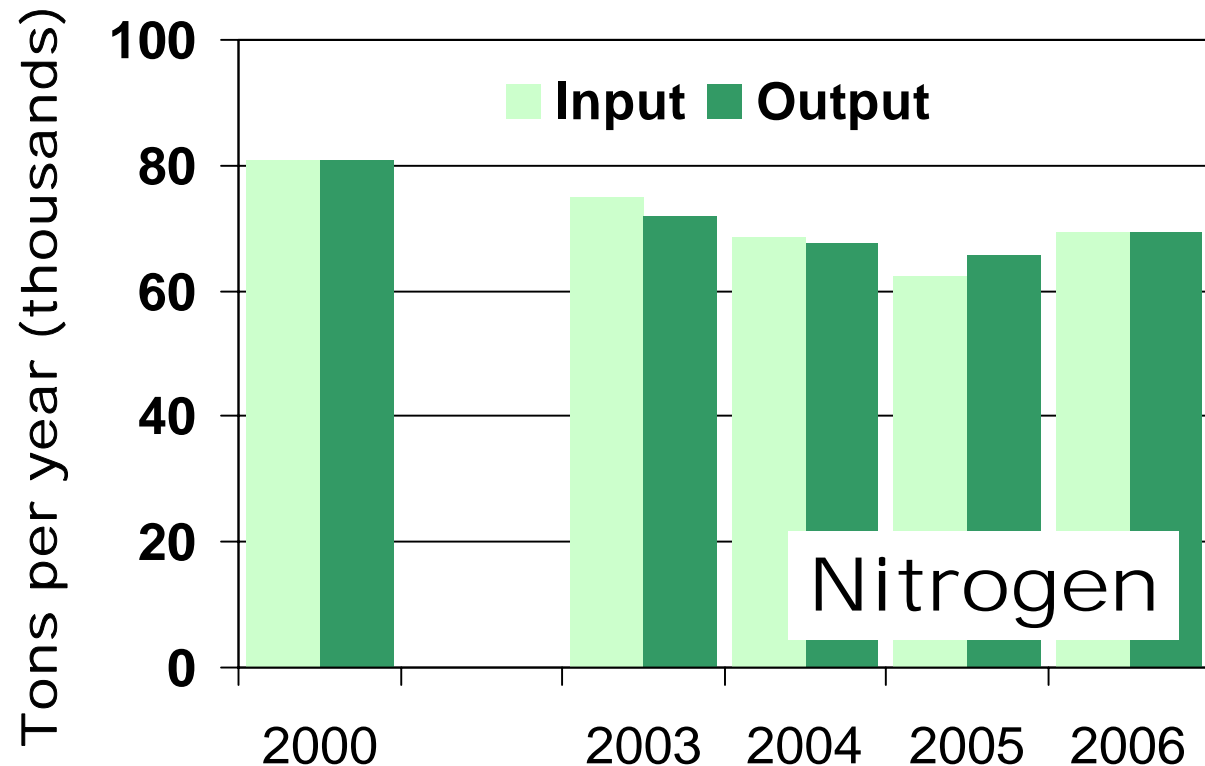
Environment: Water quality

Water quality leaving the region is as good as incoming.

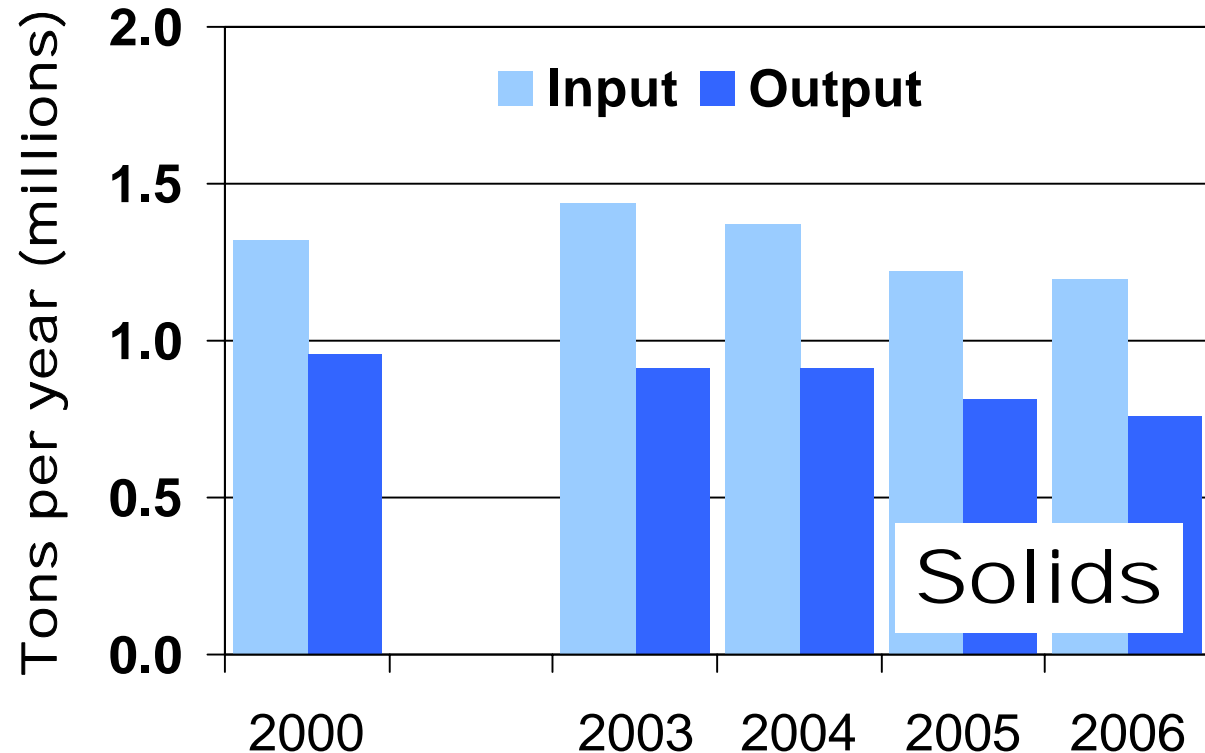

Environment: Air quality

- **Target and actual:**
No federal standards violations
- **Air Quality Index:** 4 alerts for ozone in 2006; 2 for particulate matter



Environment: Water supply

- Develop master plan to assure adequate, secure water supply
- Work with state and local officials to streamline regulatory process
