## Proposed Action/Motion

It is recommended that the Metropolitan Council certifies that Shakopee Interceptors MSB 7024, MSB 7023, MSB 6904, and Lift Station L16 are in good operating condition.

## Issue(s)

- Minn. Stat. 473.111 requires that facilities be brought up to good operating condition prior to being transferred to a local unit of government.

## Overview and Funding

Metropolitan Council Business Item 2005-55 authorized the negotiation and execution of a reconveyance agreement with the City of Shakopee as the local benefiting unit of government. The Metropolitan Council and the City of Shakopee executed a reconveyance agreement, and repairs on the interceptors and Lift Station L16, as agreed to in the reconveyance agreement, have been completed. The Metropolitan Council must certify, pursuant to Minn. Stat. 473.111, that the interceptors and Lift Station L16 are in good operating condition.
