Subject: 2008 Sole Source Procurement of Maintenance Services for Software and Hardware

Proposed Action:

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to make ongoing maintenance and support service payments on a sole-source basis for installed software and hardware, with the service to be procured from the vendors on the attached *2008 Information Services Sole Source Vendor List* up to the amount listed.

Summary of Committee Discussion / Questions:

After a short presentation, Rich Halsted, Manager of Contracts and Dave Hinrichs, Chief Information Officer answered questions. In response to a question about the procurement process, it was stated that the Metropolitan Council utilizes a variety of hardware and software technology in the operation of its business functions. This technology is acquired through competitive procurements and requires on-going maintenance and support service agreements to ensure that the technology is kept current. When the decision is made to buy technology from a vendor, the maintenance and support of that technology is provided by that vendor or an approved subcontractor – thus making these services a Sole Source procurement.

In response to a question about the number of vendors on the list, it was noted that the Council is continually looking for opportunities to reduce and consolidate the number of hardware and software agreements that are necessary to support business functions. A good example is the Peoplesoft financial and human resource systems installed for use across the Council. Peoplesoft is now owned by Oracle, and so is our Synergen system, so maintenance and support for a variety of Oracle software packages are procured through a single consolidated bill with Oracle. The Information Services Sole Source Vendor list is updated annually as a result of price changes and merger and acquisition activity in the vendor market.

The Management Committee unanimously approved the proposal at its November 14, 2007 meeting.

Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to make ongoing maintenance and support service payments on a sole-source basis for installed software and hardware, with the services to be procured from the vendors on the attached *2008 Information Services Sole Source Vendor List* up to the amount listed.

Issue(s)

Much of the hardware and software purchased by the Council requires ongoing maintenance and support. In some cases license fees must be paid on an annual basis. Competitive procurements for the hardware and software have already been completed; this item addresses ongoing maintenance and support services.

These software and hardware services meet the Council's requirements for Sole Source Procurement in that the services are unique, the uniqueness is substantially related to the objective of the services, and that similar services are unable to meet the required objective.

Overview and Funding

Authorization to purchase these types of services on a sole source basis is requested annually. This request provides for the authorization of an updated list of vendors and services for 2008.

Purchases will generally be made by purchase order or by extension of previously executed maintenance agreements. The Regional Administrator will either authorize the purchase or delegate the authority to authorize the purchase as appropriate under Council *Policy 3-3 Expenditures* and Council *Procedure 3-3c Delegation of Procurement and Contract Authority*.

Funding for these software and hardware services is included in the Council's operating budget.
