Proposed Action

Background

The Council has previously submitted the PHA Plan for its Section 8 Program covering Fiscal Years 2000 and 2001 and for both the Section 8 and the Public Housing Programs for Fiscal Years 2002-2008. The Plan includes basic housing agency policies and references to source documents that reflect current operations, programs, and services. It is intended to be a convenient source of information for program participants, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and the general public.
