MOTION: The TAB amended the 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add HPP project SP #6284-141, I-35W from 694 to Lexington Ave – Study for future investments.

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION:

This amendment is needed to identify \$364,968 in HPP funds that were appropriated in the Interstate Maintenance Discretionary program of the 2008 Appropriations Act for I-35W Reconstruction Design. The program requires a 10% match that will be funded with state trunk highway funds. The amendment is needed to identify this project in State Fiscal year 2009 so that the study can begin before the draft 2009-2012 TIP is approved in September.

Additional background material is attached.

At its June 18, 2008 meeting, the TAB was short of a quorum. The members in attendance voted to adopt this amendment and the absent members voted by email following the meeting to reach majority decision by quorum.

As per the TAB Bylaws, whenever we request an email vote on an action item, the item will be on the following month's agenda for information, further discussion and confirmation of the vote. This item will be on the July 16, 2008 TAB agenda.

\$814,968 of federal funding has been appropriated in the Interstate Maintenance Discretionary program of the 2008 Appropriations Bill for I-35W Reconstruction Design, New Brighton, MN. A portion of these funds (\$364,968) will be used to do a feasibility study and assessment of design concepts. The program requires a 10% match that will be funded with State funds.
