Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council adopt the Public Hearing Drafts of the 2009 Unified Operating Budget, 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program and 2009 Authorized Capital Program and Budget

Issue(s)

The Metropolitan Council will hold a Public Hearing on the 2009 Unified Operating Budget, 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program and 2009 Authorized Capital Program and Budget at 5:00 PM on November 12, 2008.

Rationale and Funding

The Public Hearing Draft of the 2009 Unified Operating Budget is consistent with the Preliminary Budget adopted by the Council in August except for a decrease of \$4 million to the proposed NorthStar Commuter Rail Service operating budget. \$2 million of the decrease is due to changes in Insurance Expense and Retention Financing and \$2 million due to performing maintenance internally.
