WHEREAS,	The Council adopted a proposed 2009-2014 capital improvement plan and 2009 authorized

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

WHEREAS.

THAT the Metropolitan Council approves the 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Plan, to include supplemental information required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 473.39, Subdivision 4, and 2009 Authorized Capital Program and Budget as follows:

- 1. Adopt the 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Plan in an amount totaling \$ 2,810,382,588.
- 2. Approve \$ 101,400,000 in new multi-year capital program authorization in the 2009 Authorization Capital Program for Environmental Services.
- 3. Approve a 2009 Authorized Capital Program of \$ 3,146,814,394, including:
 - \$ 1,139,000,000 for Environmental Services,
 - \$ 1,932,615,141 for Transit, and
 - \$ 75,199,253 for Parks and Open Space.
- 4. Approve a 2009 Capital Expenditure Budget of \$ 440,742,595 for previously approved capital projects and new capital projects authorized in the 2009 Authorized Capital Program, including:
 - \$ 159,272,000 for Environmental Services,
 - \$ 252,977,292 for Transit, and
 - \$ 28,493,303 for Parks and Open Space.
