### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council concur with Transportation Advisory Board action to amend the 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include 10 projects with a total federal amount of \$7,791,806 to receive Transportation Enhancements ARRA funds.

### **Background**

The amendment is needed to allocate the ARRA Transportation Enhancements funds. The amendment would add additional funding for four projects currently in the 2009-2012 TIP and add six new projects to be funded in whole or in part by ARRA funds. The ten projects are:
