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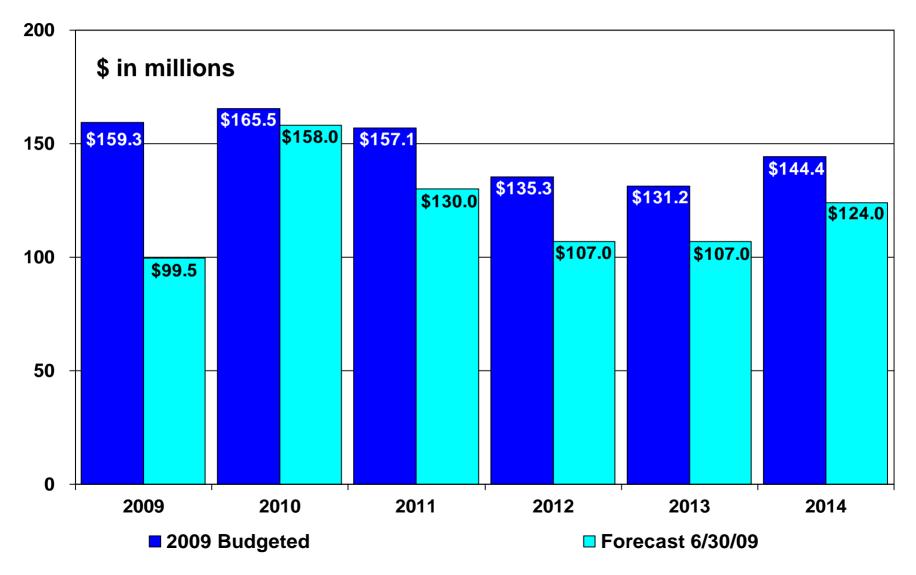


Mission Statement Environmental Services

Emerging Issues Environmental Services

- Recession has made serious debt in Service Availability Charge (SAC) reserve balance. We are still are looking at changes to methodology for 2010.
- Also sensitive to holding down Municipal Wastewater Charge (MWC) increases in a soft economy
- Several passes at reducing the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) spending
 - Focusing on rehab
 - Deferring expansion projects
 - Positioning for stimulus funds
- Lake Pepin Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) of phosphorus may require further reduction (from 1.0 mg/L to .3 mg/L)

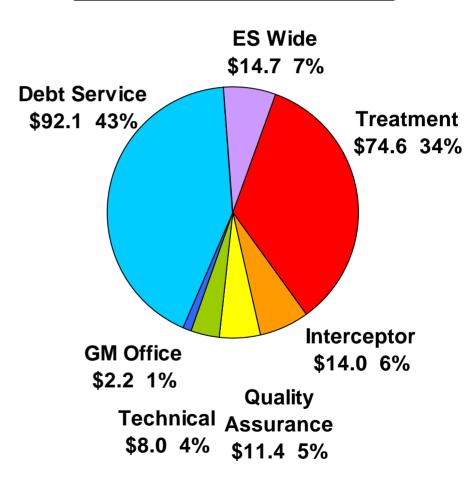

Expenditures & Uses



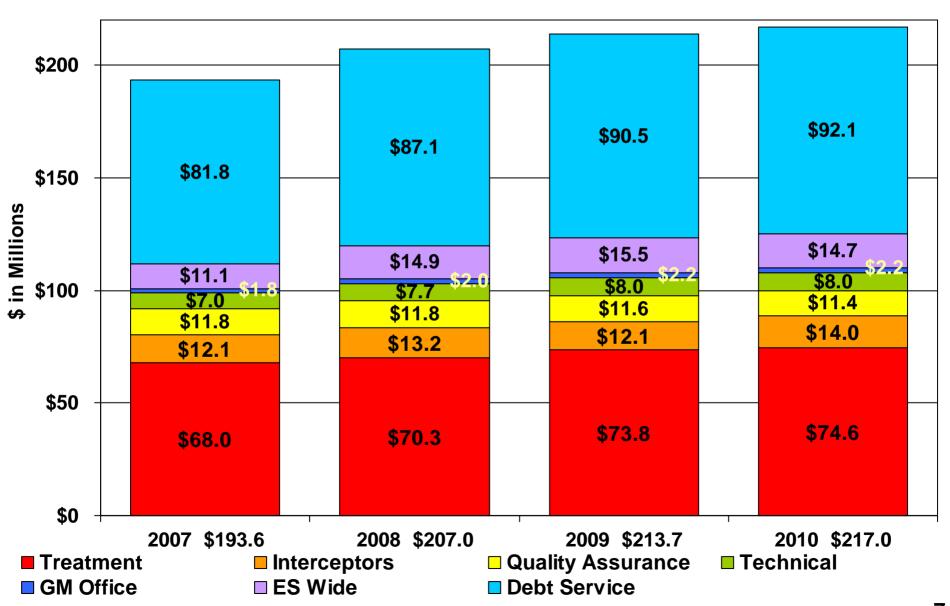
Revenues and Sources by Type

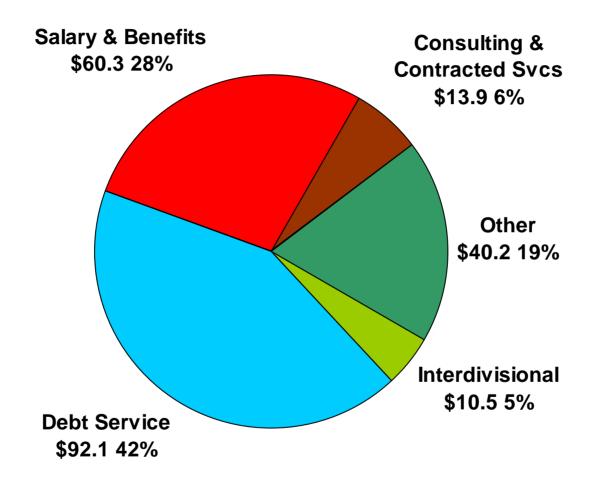


Expenditures and Uses by Function
