




Accommodating growth: Net housing growth






Accommodating growth: Housing location goal








Daily roadway use: VMTs per capita per day




Transportation: Traffic congestion






Transportation: Peak transit capacity





Transportation: Transit Ridership






Housing Choices: Housing Production




Housing Choices: Housing Production






Housing Choices: Affordable rental






Housing Choices: Affordable ownership






Housing Choices: Percent affordable permits



Air Quality Index Days of "unhealthy" air






Protecting natural resources: Water quality

 Goal: the quality of the water leaving the metro area is as good as the water's quality entering the metro area, and in compliance with federal and state regulations.






Water quality: Phosphorus






Water quality: Solids
