Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute an architectural/engineering services agreement with TKDA in the amount not to exceed \$1,613,777 for East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant Design and Construction Phase Services, Contract No. 09P160 MCES Project No. 801620.

Background

This contract is to provide architectural/engineering design and construction phase services for the East Bethel Water Reclamation plant. Six proposals were received. The proposals were evaluated on the following criteria:

- The quality of the proposal
- The qualifications of the proposer
- The experience of the proposer
- The price of the proposal

The evaluation committee found that five of the proposals were similar in quality and that the proposers demonstrated the qualifications and experience necessary to complete the project successfully. The sixth proposal was determined to be marginal in terms of quality and price. Of the five proposals of similar quality, price became the differentiating factor in making a recommendation for selection of a firm.

The prices of the proposal ranged from \$1,613,777 to \$2,977,280. TKDA offered the low price of \$1,613,777.

Rationale

Professional service contracts with an amount exceeding \$250,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.
