Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to execute a grant agreement with MVTA for up to \$550,000 for land acquisition for expansion of the Eagan Bus Garage.

Background

MVTA will receive up to \$550,000 in regional transit capital (RTC) funds to acquire an acre of land next to the Eagan Bus Garage for its expansion. The funds will also be used for legal fees and other incidental costs occurring with the acquisition.

Rationale

These grants allow regional transit providers and transit capital sponsor agencies to fund transit capital projects using regional transit capital funds distributed by the Metropolitan Council.

Funding

The funding for this grant includes \$550,000 in regional transit capital funds for the project that is included in the 2010 Authorized Capital Program.
