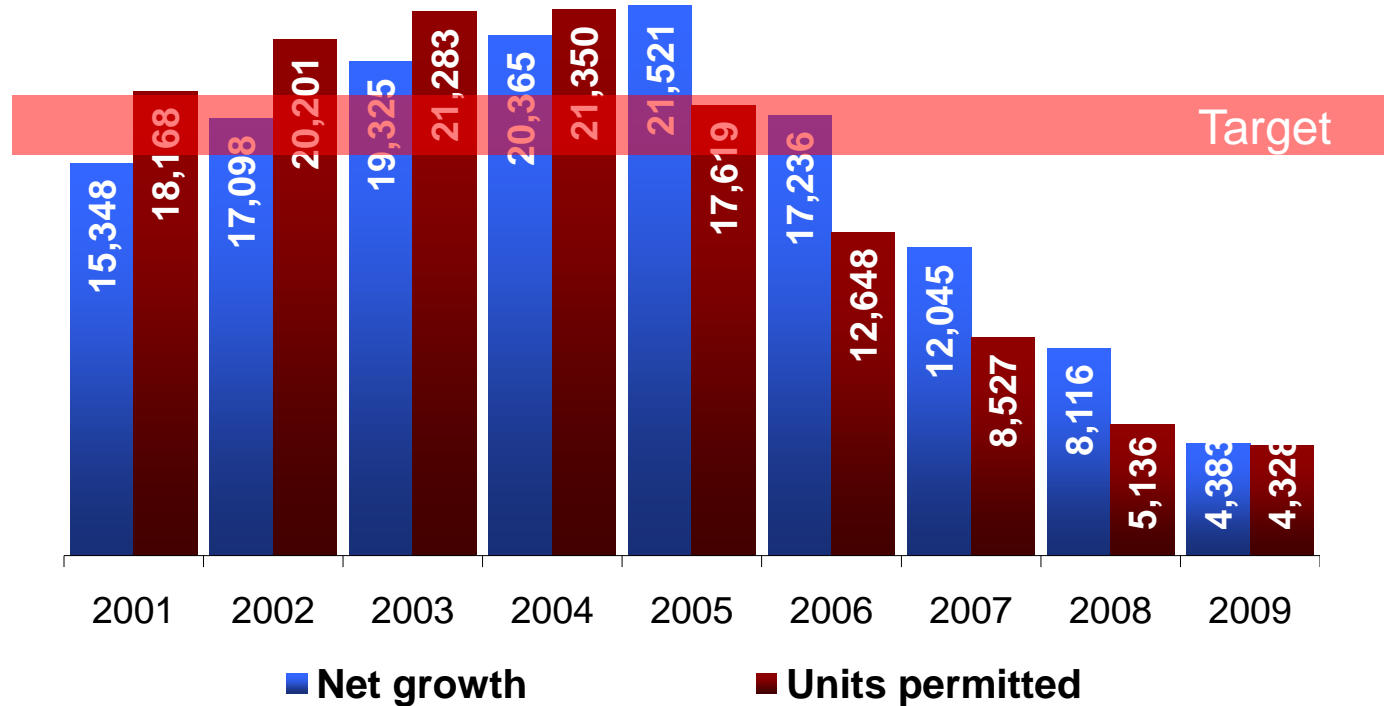

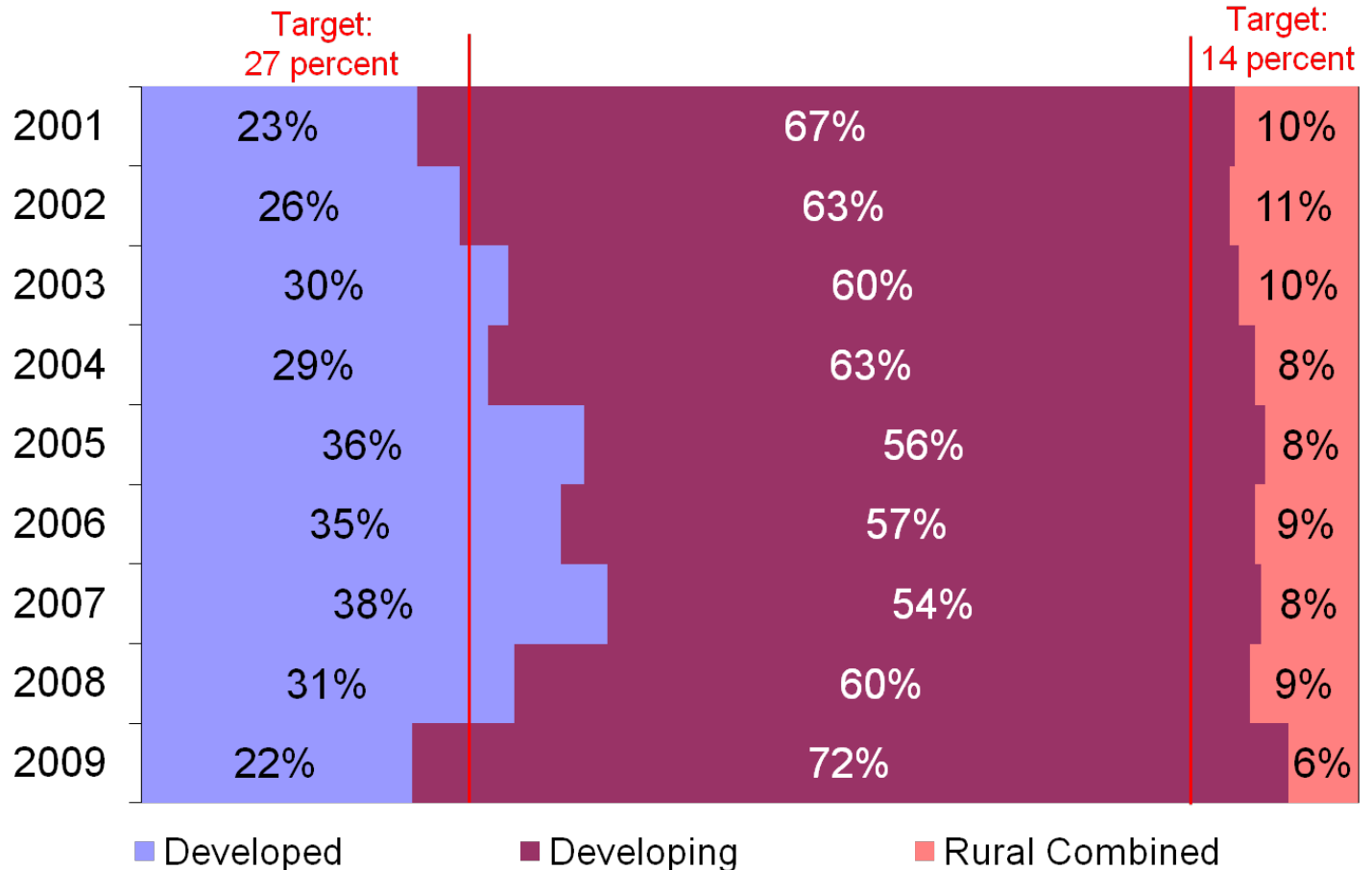

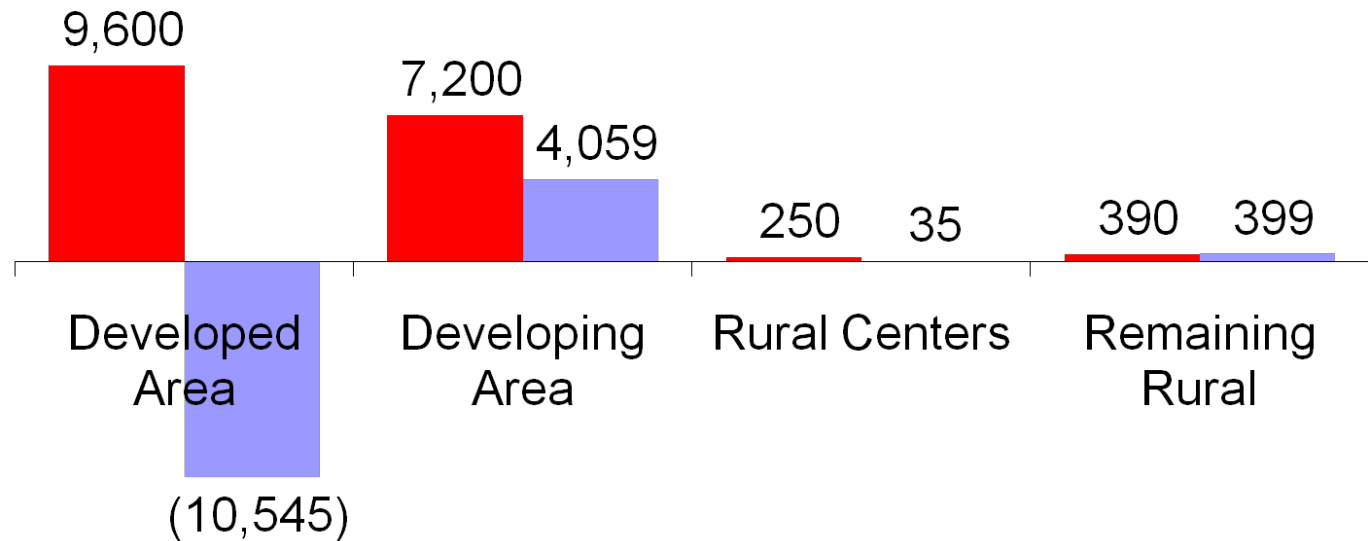

Actual: 56,581 jobs lost



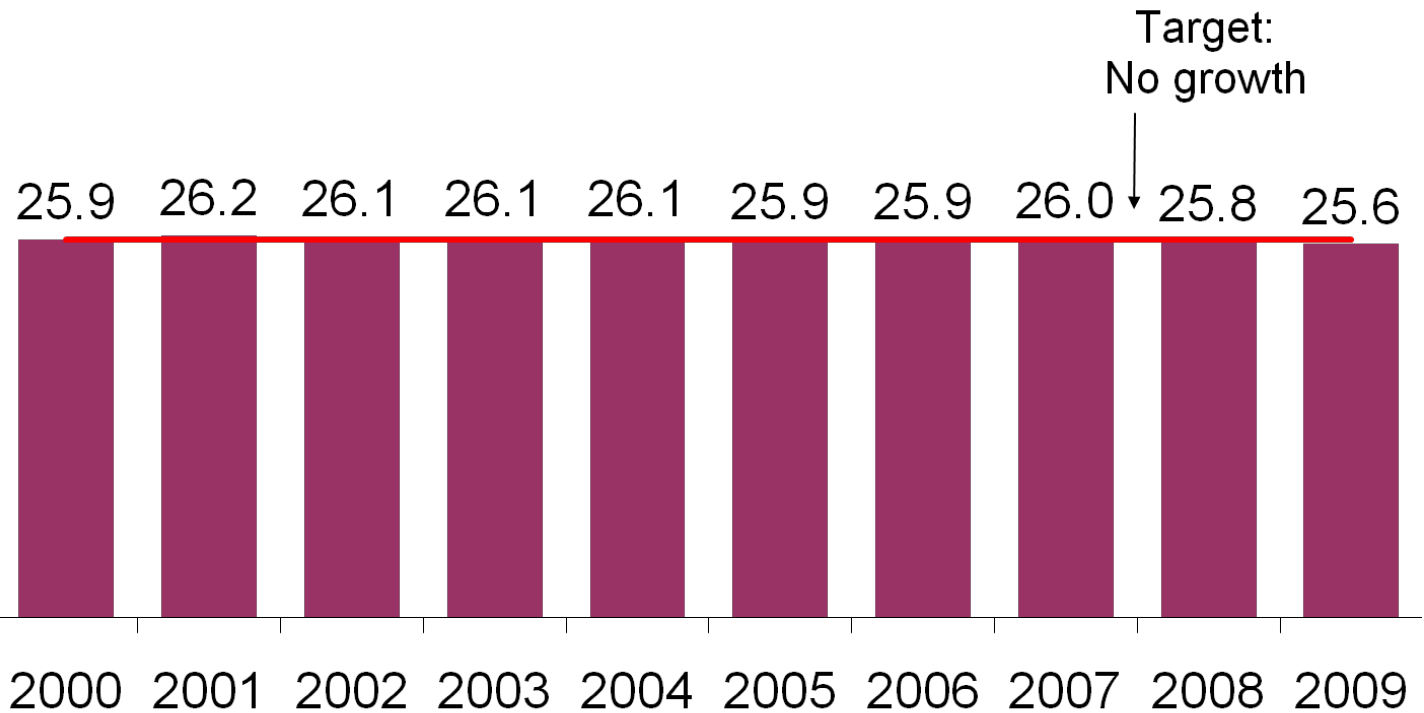
■ Target Average Annual Change ■ Actual Average Annual Change

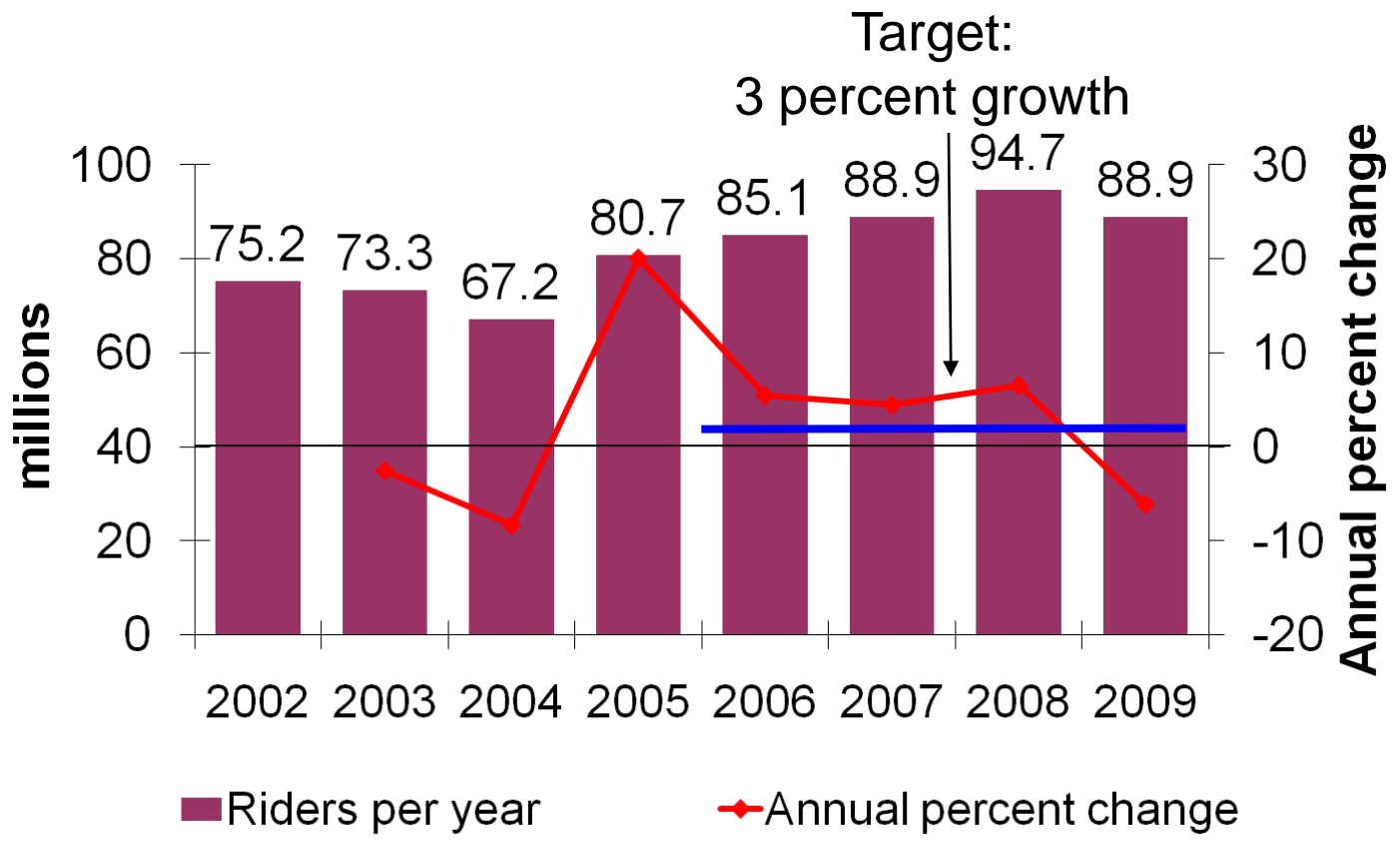
# Daily roadway use: VMTs per capita per day





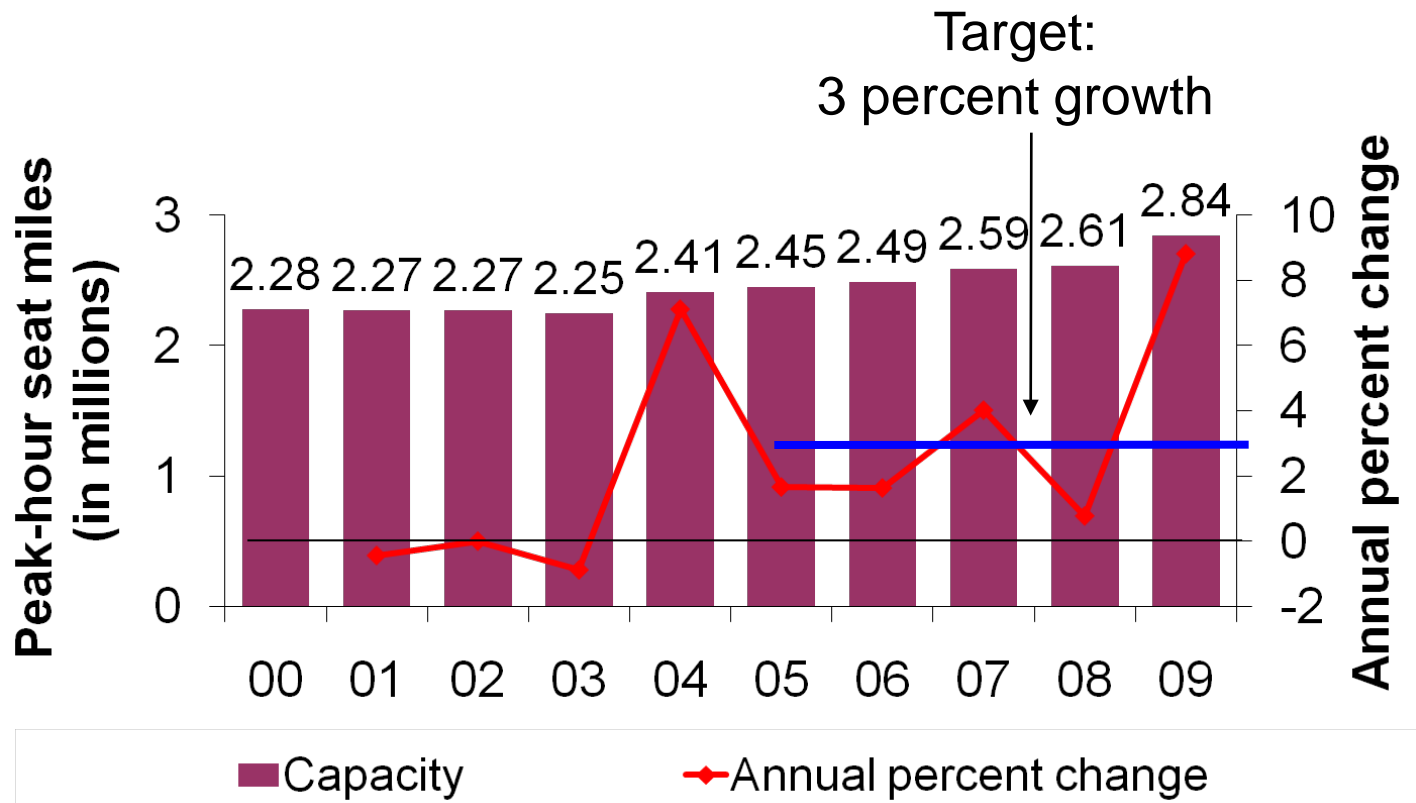


# Transportation: Transit Ridership





# Transportation: Peak transit capacity





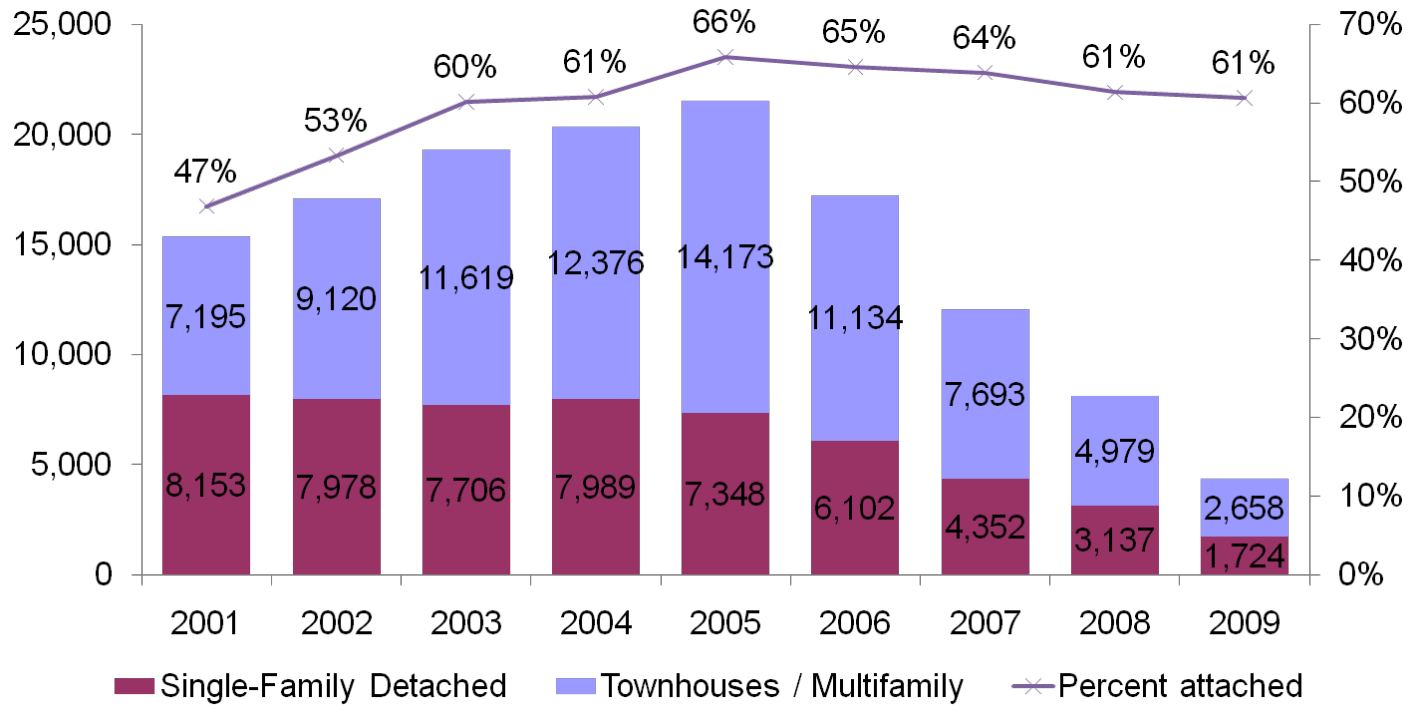

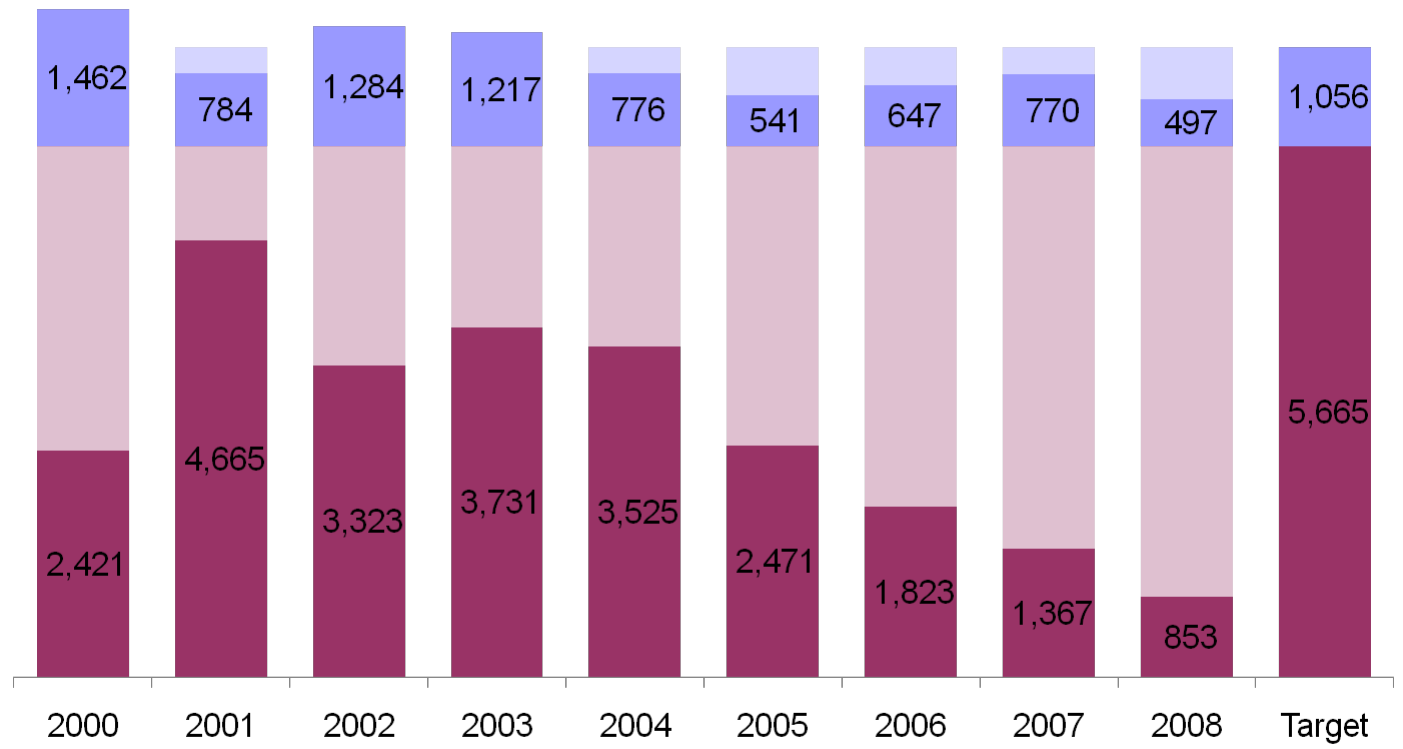

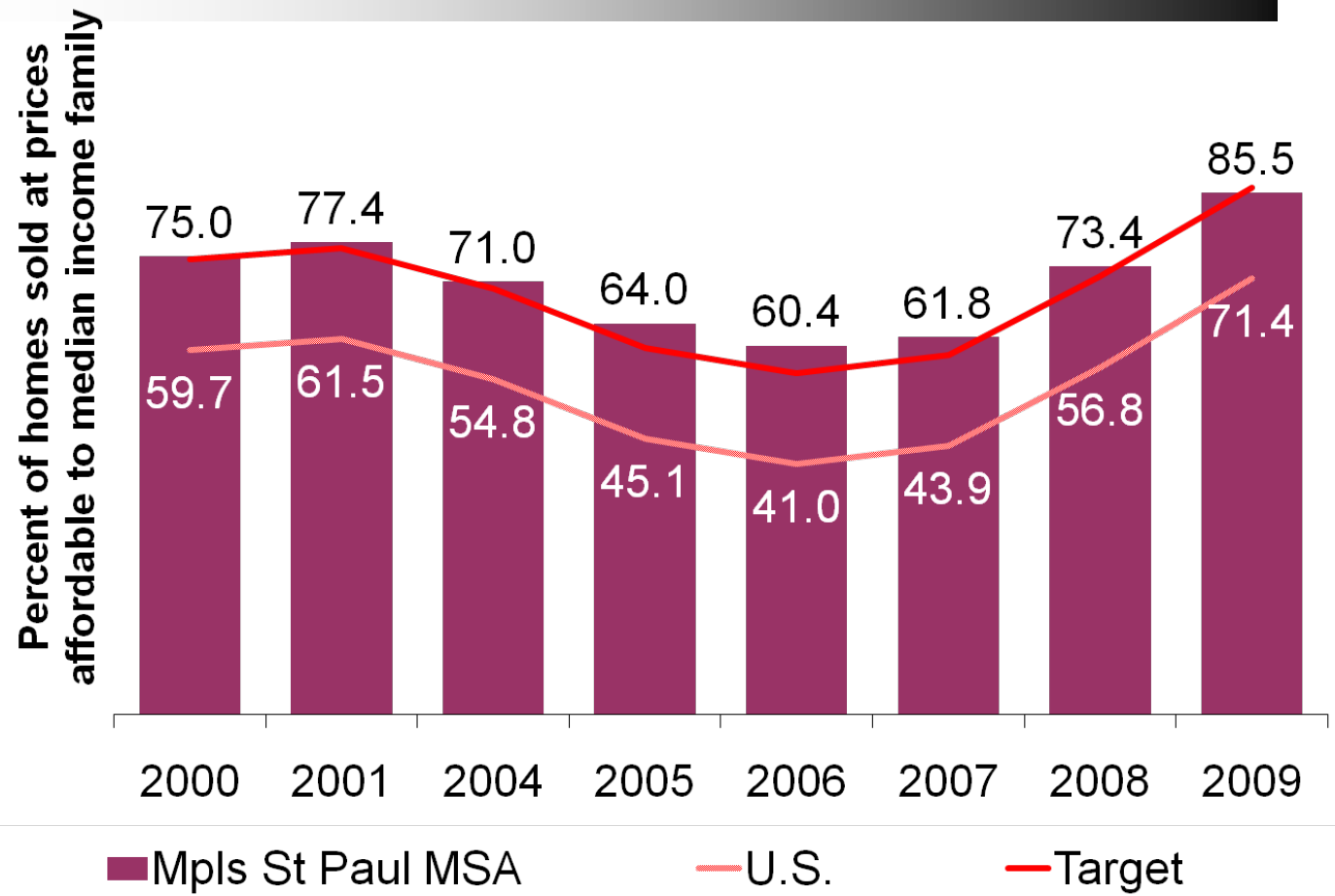

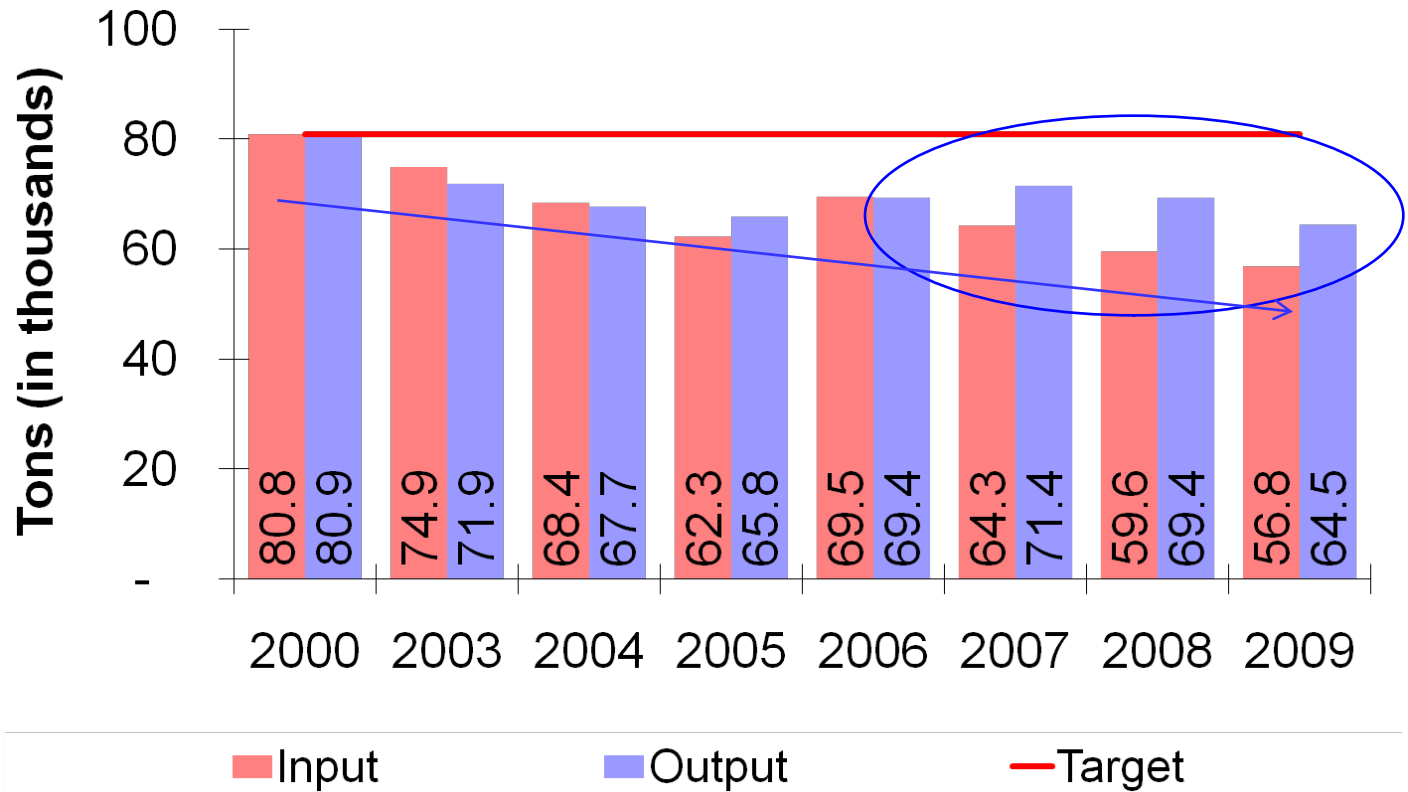
# Water quality: Phosphorus



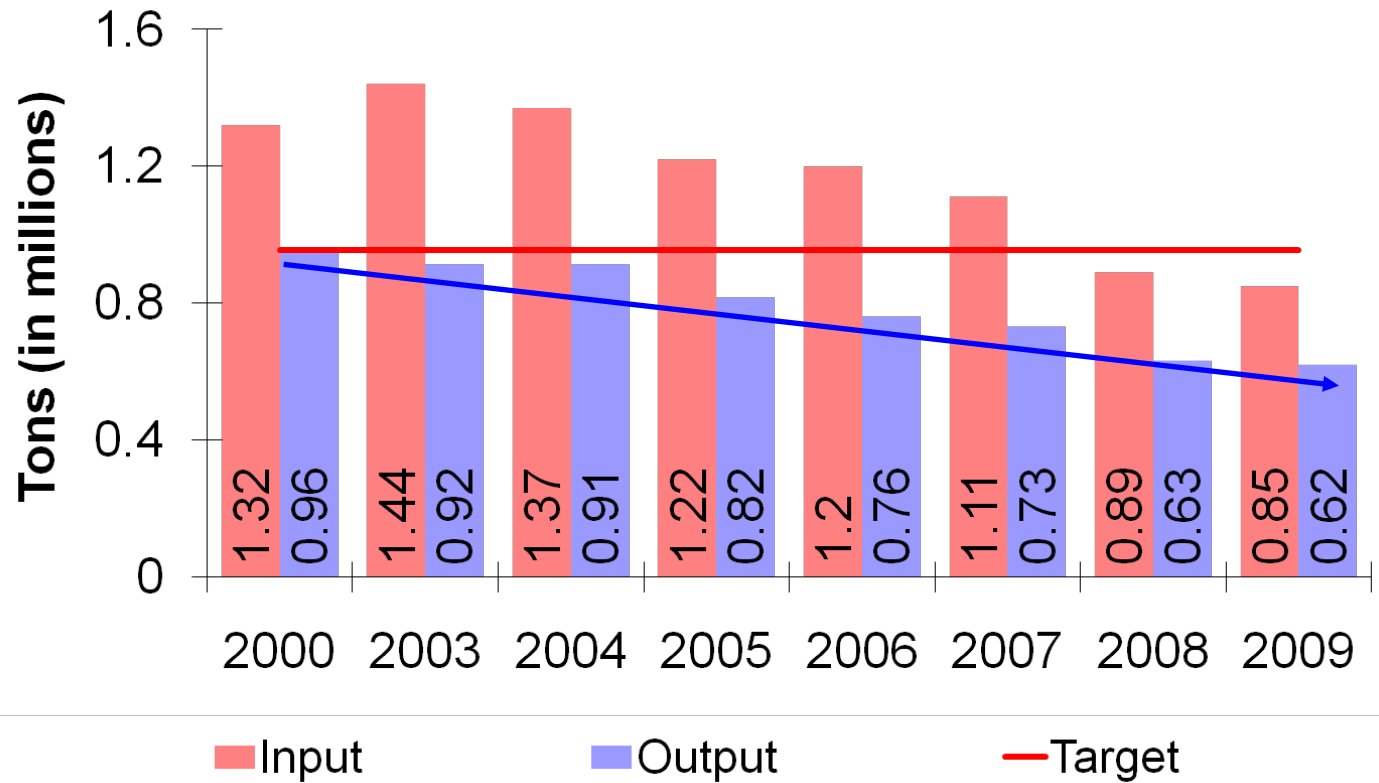




# Water quality: Nitrogen
