Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to execute a sub-recipient grant agreement with the Hennepin County Regional Railroad Authority for \$250,000 in federal funds to conduct alternatives analysis and initiate environmental analysis (Draft Environmental Impact Statement) for the Bottineau Transitway.

Background

Hennepin County RRA will receive \$250,000 in federal Section 5339 Alternatives Analysis funds to support the ongoing alternative analysis effort on Bottineau Transitway. The county will provide the required 20 percent match with local funds in the amount of \$62,500.

Rationale

This grant allows Hennepin County RRA to fund the ongoing alternatives analysis effort on Bottineau Transitway using federal earmark funds appropriated for this purpose.

Funding

The funding for this grant is entirely federal Section 5339 Alternatives Analysis allocated for the specified project and included in the Council's 2010 Authorized Capital Program.

Known Support / Opposition

These funds were requested by the local congressional delegation in coordination with Hennepin County.
