### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include SP#091-595-025: Union Depot Multimodal Transit Facility.

### Background

Ramsey County Railroad Authority was awarded \$40M of 2010 US DOT High Speed Rail Grant funds. These funds need to be added to the TIP to support other federal funds now in the TIP for Union Depot Multimodal Transit Facility construction. Due to the December scheduled bid package issuance for the existing and new funds, this amendment did not go through TAC but instead to the TAB Executive Committee prior to the TAB Programming Committee.

- **MOTION:** The TAB adopted an amendment to the 2011-2014 TIP to include SP# 091-595-025: Union Depot Multimodal Transit Facility, St. Paul – Construction (2010 High Speed Rail Grant).

**BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION**: In late October, Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority (RCRRA) was awarded \$40M of 2010 U.S. DOT High Speed Rail Grant Program Funds identified in the 2010 Omnibus Legislation. These funds need to be included in the TIP prior to issuance of bid package 2 so that the funds can be used in combination with the other available Federal funding to support the construction work.

In order to maintain the schedule, the second bid package needs to be released in December 2010 so that awards can be made in February 2011 for major work to be underway during the 2011 construction season. The second bid package includes all of the work necessary to complete the project and was to be funded with TIGER and Section 1301 funding, already in the TIP. Delaying bid package 2 would delay the entire project and add inflationary and administrative costs. There is not enough time to process the TIP amendment through the regular TAC/TAB process and still meet the December schedule to include these funds in the release of the second bid package. For that reason, the TAB Executive Committee recommended that this amendment is brought directly to the TAB Programming Committee and full TAB for consideration on November 17.

The grant is available through the U.S. Department of Transportation and will be administered by MN/DOT.

### PROJECT BACKGROUND:

 Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g. project in previous TIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in TIP). Note that this amendment is following an abbreviated approval in that is being presented directly to the TAB. The reason for this is for scheduling purposes.

The schedule for the Union Depot project was developed to meet program requirements for the 2009 FRA/ARRA funding that required completion in 2012. Project development has proceeded on that schedule. The project did not receive funding in that round, but did receive \$35 million in TIGER funds. The schedule has moved forward with a combination of the TIGER funding, \$45.3 million in SAFETEA-LU 1301 funds, and local funding. The first bid package of locally-funded work was released in October. Those bids are expected to be awarded in late November-early December, with work beginning in January. The first bids will be for demolition, piling, earthwork, abatement and other activities that will prepare the site for major construction in the spring of 2011.

In order to maintain the schedule, the second bid package needs to be released in December 2010 so that awards can be made in February 2011 for major work to be underway during the 2011 construction season. The second bid package includes all of the work necessary to complete the project. The second bid package was to be funded with TIGER and Section 1301 funding, already in the TIP. In late October, Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority (RCRRA) was awarded \$40M of 2010 U.S. DOT High Speed Rail Grant Program Funds identified in the 2010 Omnibus Legislation. These funds need to be included in the TIP prior to issuance of bid package 2 so that the funds can be used in combination with the other available Federal funding to support the construction work. Delaying bid package 2 would delay the entire project and add inflationary and administrative costs. The grant is available through FHWA and will be administered by MnDOT.

This amendment is needed to identify these grant funds in the 2011-2014 TIP.
