Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to award and execute a construction contract for Regional Meter Improvements – Phase 1, MCES Project Number 805600, Contract No. 10P180, with Lametti & Sons for their low bid of \$4,428,255.

Background

This project consists of proposed improvements to existing interceptor facilities. The proposed improvements are required to replace deteriorated and/or undersized meter facilities. This contract includes the rehabilitation of 11 meters located in St Paul, Woodbury, Robbinsdale, Mounds View, Coon Rapids, Brooklyn Park and Eden Prairie.

A formal Invitation for Bids (IFB) was advertised and issued for the construction contract. Four bids were received on November 30, 2010, ranging from \$4,428,255 to \$6,936,861. Lametti & Sons submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$4,428,255. The low bid was approximately 4% below the engineer’s estimate of \$4,598,502.

Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

Funding

Funding is provided in the 2010 MCES Capital Budget, Project Number 805600.
