## **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to award and execute a construction contract for Regional Meter Improvements – Phase 2, MCES Project Number 805600, Contract No. 10P181, with Lametti & Sons for their low bid of \$1,253,700.

## **Background**

This project consists of proposed improvements to existing interceptor facilities. The proposed improvements are required to replace deteriorated and/or undersized meter facilities. This contract includes the rehabilitation of five meters located in Maplewood, St Paul, Minneapolis and Minnetonka.

A formal Invitation for Bids (IFB) was advertised and issued for the construction contract. Five bids were received on November 30, 2010, ranging from \$1,253,700 to \$2,073,288. Lametti & Sons submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$1,253,700. The low bid was approximately 25% above the engineer's estimate of \$958,995.

#### Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

## **Funding**

Funding is provided in the 2010 MCES Capital Budget, Project Number 805600.
