Subject: Authorization to Amend Contract with MCI to Allow Price Increase

## **Proposed Action:**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to amend the bus purchase contract with Motor Coach Industries (MCI) to increase the per unit vehicle contract price by \$21,720 in order to comply with 2010 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) emissions standards.

# **Summary of Committee Discussion / Questions:**

Council member Scherer asked how many buses were subject to the price increase, and Chuck Wurzinger answered that it applied to the single bus MTS is purchasing. He also said that 26 buses were purchased originally under this contract and that 86 option buses were available, although a small number of those have been purchased. The price increase will apply to future buses purchased under this contract, just as similar price increases have applied to Gillig and New Flyer buses purchased recently.

Council member Steffen asked how long this price would remain applicable. Chuck Wurzinger answered that the only price increases allowed under the contract are those related to the Producer Price Index or regulations changes such as the 2010 EPA emissions changes.

A motion was made by Councilmember Aguilar, seconded by Councilmember Steffen, and then approved unanimously.

#### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to amend the bus purchase contract with Motor Coach Industries (MCI) to increase the per unit vehicle contract price by \$21,720 in order to comply with 2010 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) emissions standards.

## **Background**

Transit buses must meet the EPA emissions standards which took effect in January 2010. Bus manufacturers must design and install exhaust after-treatment systems in their buses to meet these new standards.

Metropolitan Transportation Services is ordering a bus under the Council's contract with MCI which will involve a vehicle price increase due to the EPA mandate. This contract contains a clause that provides for the price adjustment related to the new EPA emissions regulations.

#### Rationale

Staff has reviewed the detailed price change information with MCI and the engine manufacturer, and finds that the recommended price increase is fair and reasonable. The price increase will add approximately four percent to the per-unit vehicle price.

## **Funding**

Funding is included in the Council capital budget.

# **Known Support/Opposition**

There is no known opposition to the proposed action.
