#### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to amend Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) grant agreement (SG-2010-118) with Minnesota Valley Transit Authority (MVTA) in the amount of \$400,000 for a revised total of \$600,000.

#### **Background**

The grant agreement is for the procurement of components to implement an AVL system for MVTA, including automated passenger counters, voice annunciation, and fare box integration. Per MVTA, the system will be compatible with the regional system.

#### Rationale

These types of grants allow regional transit providers and transit capital sponsor agencies to fund transit capital projects using regional transit capital (RTC) funds distributed by the Metropolitan Council.

#### **Funding**

MVTA is using \$400,000 of its federal formula National Transit Database (NTD) earnings. The Council is providing the RTC in lieu of federal funds.

### **Known Support / Opposition**

These additional funds were requested by MVTA.
