Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to negotiate a contract with Egan Company in an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for the service, maintenance and installation of Verint Camera systems and Siemens AVL systems over a three year period.

Background

Metropolitan Transportation Services (MTS) currently operates 262 buses equipped with security camera systems with the potential of adding these systems to another 195 buses over the next three years.

A formal Invitation for Bids was issued on March 23, 2011 to provide maintenance and installation services on new and existing Verint Camera and Siemens AVL systems. There were six document holders for this project. Egan Co. was determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Rationale

A three year contract will provide for the maintenance, installation and transfer of Verint surveillance systems. This contract will also include the installation of new and transfer of existing Siemens AVL equipment.

Funding

The first year of funding for this maintenance contract is included in the 2011 Unified Operating Budget. The future anticipated costs for this contract will be included in the next two Unified Operating Budgets.
