


What does Corridors of Opportunity seek to achieve?

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


The initiative includes many activities by many partners advance the vision

- Over \$20,000,000 of grants & loans
 - HUD: \$5M planning grant
 - Living Cities: \$2.7M grant; \$10M commercial loans; \$3M PRI
- 2 dozen discrete "projects"
- Planning, research, real estate development & small business expansion




What is the role of Corridors of Opportunity vis-à-vis the Council?



What did Corridors of Opportunity achieve in 2011?

Established new partnerships that will enable our region to be more competitive.



What did Corridors of Opportunity achieve in 2011?

Distributed nearly \$400,000 to 10 organizations on 4 corridors to engage underrepresented communities in unique ways.



Low income people


People of color

What did Corridors of Opportunity achieve in 2011?

- Initiated the 7 "corridor TOD strategies" (studies, plans, and projects to support equitable TOD)
- Recommended the inclusion of corridorwide affordable housing plans in these strategies.



What did Corridors of Opportunity <u>partner</u> organizations achieve in 2011?

Partners aligned their programs and policies to support the vision of equitable TOD. For example:

- Metropolitan Council LCA TOD program
- Minnesota Housing funding focus on TOD





What's ahead in 2012 for Corridors of Opportunity?

- Fund pre-development of several TOD projects (\$1million)
- Complete the corridor TOD strategies
- Complete this phase of Program of Projects
- Engage additional underrepresented communities (~\$300,000)
