Call to Order and Approval of Agenda

2012-27 Central Corridor Light Rail Transit (Green Line): Authorization to Approve Contract Amendment for Environmental Testing and Monitoring during Construction

"That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to: Execute an amendment to the professional services contract with Braun Intertec for environmental testing and monitoring during construction as part of the Central Corridor LRT (Green Line) project in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 for a total amended contract value of \$1,049,229.26."

2012-28 Minneapolis Interchange Project – Programmatic Agreement

"That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to take the following actions required to satisfactorily complete the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process:

• Sign the Minneapolis Interchange Project Programmatic Agreement, developed jointly between the Federal Transit Administration, Hennepin County Regional Railroad

- Authority, the Metropolitan Council, and the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Office pursuant to federal regulations.
- Execute a Cooperative Agreement with Hennepin County and Hennepin County Regional Railroad Authority identifying the County as the entity with primary responsibility for implementing the terms of the Programmatic Agreement."

Reports

Chair. Chair Haigh reported on recent meetings and events. Highlights include:

- Attended regular monthly meeting with MnDoT to discuss joint issues between MnDoT and MC.
- Met with leaders for Isaiah Summit which is coming up this Sunday. Will focus on issues involving Metropolitan Council.
- Attended Central Corridor Management Committee meeting; received update on lessons learned.
- Attended Urban Initiative Board meeting, which is led by DEED, involving a loan program supporting investment in economic development activities within the urban area.

Council Members

- Cunningham. Attended open house in north Minneapolis, where a lively discussion took place regarding Bottineau Transitway. Attended celebration of Green Leaf Apartments community opening, which received Livable Communities affordable housing grant.
- Munt. Introduced herself at precinct caucus, where there was a lot of interest in the work of the Metropolitan Council. Transit for Livable Communities urged people to bring a resolution to caucus asking people to support bonding for SW and funding to keep bus fares affordable.
- Elkins. Attended the first meeting of the year of the GEARS committee.
- Wulff. Participated in tour hosted by Dakota County of the station areas along the Red Line (Cedar Avenue BRT).
- Rummel. Attended monthly Metro Energy Policy Coalition meeting, where there was extended discussion about the viability of solar energy and its application to local units of government. Also attended Municipal Legislative Commission meeting.
- Melander. Also attended Municipal Legislative Commission meeting, and a couple of events dealing with legislative issues. Two people approached him and talked about all the good work that Environmental Services has done in regard to energy conservation.
- Van Eyll. Met with Scott County regarding flood mitigation on highway 101.

Regional Administrator. Governor has asked the Metropolitan Council, in conjunction with MnDOT and DNR, to perform economic impact analysis of the potential closure of the upper St. Anthony Lock and Dam in Minneapolis for the purpose of providing a barrier to potential infestation of the Asian Carp. Project will be funded by DNR, MnDOT, and possibly some Council funds. Council will release RFP today for consultant to undertake work, and results will be brought to Council

General Counsel. No report.
