Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include Section 5309 FTA discretionary funding for construction of The Interchange project in downtown Minneapolis.

Background

This amendment is needed because Hennepin County received a \$10M grant from the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Program. These funds, adminstered as Section 5309 funds by the Federal Transit Administration must be identified in the current TIP in order for the funds to become available for the intended use.

Rationale

The Transportation Advisory Board approves formal amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program. The Metropolitan Council concurs with the action of the TAB. This project and the amendment is exempt from air quality conformity analysis, is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan and does not affect fiscal constraint as it adds new federal funds awarded to Hennepin County.

This TIP amendment is being moved to the Council for same week action to allow Hennepin County to move forward with awarding the design build contract this April.

Funding

This project will be funded with a combination of FTA funds and local funds from several sources including Hennepin County and state bonds. A full financing package has not yet been finalized but will include the federal funds and county and state funds.

Known Support / Opposition

There was no opposition expressed. The amendment is supported by Hennepin County.
