Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to execute a purchase agreement with Eldorado (MnDOT contract 40759) for eleven small buses in an amount not to exceed \$795,000.

Background

This procurement is in alignment with the bus replacement schedule and Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) established for Metropolitan Transportation Services (MTS).

Rationale

Vehicles will be purchased for MTS' Transit Link and contracted fixed route service to replace buses that have reached the end of their useful life. This bus acquisition utilizes the State of Minnesota Cooperative Vehicle Procurement Contract Release B-347(5) and is compliant with all State and Federal regulations.

Funding

These capital expenditures were previously included in the Metropolitan Council's Capital Improvement Plan and added to the Authorized Capital Program on October 26, 2011, with Business Item 2011-259 and November 9, 2011, with Business Item 2011-286.

Eight replacement buses will be purchased with \$401,920 in Section 5307 Federal Formula funds and \$163,080 in local Regional Transit Capital (RTC) matching funds. The remaining three buses will be purchased using \$230,000 in RTC funds.
