Background

The Office of General Counsel procures outside legal services for various public law matters. The Contract Price set in each agreement represents a cap on the amount payable; it is a "ceiling," and not a guarantee or entitlement. Regardless of any Contract Price, the actual amount paid under a legal services agreement is based upon: actual services requested and rendered, and the budget amount(s) approved by the Metropolitan Council. In order for the General Counsel to continue receiving legal services under the Foley Lardner Agreement, the Contract Price must be increased.

Rationale

The proposed amendment would allow the General Counsel to pay for legal services and third party expenses related to State v. 3M litigation.
