Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council ratify the amended scope for emergency declaration on Empire Digester Repairs.

Issue(s)

• Related process problems increased the scope of work on emergency repairs.

Overview and Funding

An emergency was declared for the Empire Wastewater Treatment Plant digester system in December 2006. A biological upset to the anaerobic system followed by failure of the pressure relief system caused structural damage to a primary digester cover. The estimate for engineering and construction to repair and stabilize the system was \$500,000. During the course of the recovery and repair process, additional structural damage occurred to a second digester cover. Repair of the second cover was added to the emergency contractor's scope of work. The repair for both covers has been completed, with the total cost being \$410,000. approximately \$710,000.
