Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute an architectural/engineering services agreement with Bolton and Menk, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$572,161 for East Bethel Reclaimed Water Distribution Design and Construction Phase Services, Contract No. 09P235, MCES Project Number 801620.

Background

This project provides architectural/engineering services for design and construction phase services for construction of 24,000 feet of 16 and 10 inch reclaimed water lines between the East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant and two land application sites. The contract also provides acquisition assistance for acquiring permanent and temporary easements necessary for construction of the project.

Eight proposals were received. The proposals were evaluated on the following criteria:

- The quality of the proposal
- The qualifications of the proposer
- The experience of the proposer
- The price of the proposal

The evaluation committee found three proposals were of similar quality and rated these proposals as very good. Other proposals were rated good or marginal.

The prices ranged from \$572,161 to \$1,207,565. Bolton and Menk, Inc. offered the lowest price among all the proposals and its proposal was rated as one of the three with the highest quality overall proposal.

Rationale

Professional services contracts with an amount exceeding \$250,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.
