### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to award and execute a construction contract for Hopkins System Improvements – Phase 1, Contract A, MCES Project Number 804120, Contract No. 10P267, with S.J. Louis Construction, Inc. for their low bid of \$7,872,000.

#### **Background**

The work includes construction of a replacement force main located generally between Dean Parkway and East Calhoun Parkway in the City of Minneapolis. It will consist of 3,200 feet of new 18- and 24-inch force main pipe, a 90-foot wide waterway crossing and construction of four maintenance structures.

A formal Invitation for Bids (IFB) was advertised and issued for the construction contract. Five bids were received on August 24, 2011, ranging from \$7,872,000 to \$9,693,178. S.J. Louis Construction submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$7,872,000. The engineer's estimate is \$9,929,998.

This project is funded by a loan from the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority (PFA), which requires disadvantaged business participation goals of 5% Minority and 10% Women Business Enterprise (MBE and WBE). S.J. Louis Construction, Inc. proposes 1.5% WBE and 6.1% MBE participation. The Council's Office of Diversity and Equal Opportunity reviewed and documented the contractor's good faith effort to meet the WBE and MBE goals.

#### Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.
