## **Proposed Action**

The Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute an amendment to Cooperative Agreement 11I031 between the Council and the City of Golden Valley for construction of the Circle Down segment of the 1-GV-461 Relief Lift Station and Forcemain Project.

## Background

The MCES needs to provide additional sanitary sewer capacity to serve the communities of St. Louis Park and Golden Valley. This service has been planned to be provided by the construction of a lift station in the vicinity of the Golden Valley/St. Louis Park border and the construction of a force main from that location to the existing Plymouth Force Main.

The MCES previously entered into Cooperative Agreement 111031 with the City of Golden Valley to design the Circle Down portion of the forcemain as part of a City street reconstruction project. The design is complete and the project is anticipated to bid in March of 2012. This amendment adds construction of the Circle Down portion of the forcemain during the spring/summer of 2012.

#### Rationale

Cooperative agreements exceeding \$250,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization. This agreement, when completed will exceed that amount.

## **Funding**

Funding for the construction of this project is provided in the 2011 Authorized Capital Program.
