MCUB Program History at Metropolitan Council

- Metropolitan Council's Policy 3-4-6 explains the DBE program used for federal funded procurements (FTA & PFA)
- For procurements not funded with federal monies, the Council does not currently have an approved Targeted Group Business Program in place

Governor Dayton's MCUB initiative

- Spring of 2011 Governor Dayton requested the Metropolitan Council to re-emphasize our commitment to Targeted Group Business (TGB)
- Governor Dayton identifies MN Department of Administration's TG/ED program as preferred vehicle to accomplish goal

Making the MCUB work at the Metropolitan Council

- MN Department of Administration's TG/ED program not a good fit with Metropolitan Council
 - Preference Points Risk of lawsuit, procurement department does not support
 - Economically Disadvantaged All 43 Minnesota counties fall outside metro region
 - Dept. of Admin TG/ED program's focus on goods and services, Metropolitan Council's program focus on construction and design projects

MCUB Program Development

- Response letter from Council Chair Haigh (December 2012) to Governor office
- Metropolitan Council is committed to Governor Dayton's inclusion efforts
- Build on our federal DBE successes
- Multi-phase plan beginning in 2012

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

What is a Met Council MCUB

- Utilizing existing certification programs no additional certification process specific to Met Council Underutilized Business
- Focused on targeting Minnesota based firms
- Continued Met Council efforts to support Minnesota Veterans

MCUB Contracts - Criteria



MCUB Goals will be put on contracts if:

- Locally funded design & construction projects over \$100,000
- Contracts have subcontracting opportunities
- There are MCUB firms available to perform the work

MCUB Contracts — Setting Goals

- Met Council MCUB pool is different than DBE pool
- Do not have data to support Met Councils blanket 15% DBE Goal
- MCUB contracts represent a wide variety of work scopes
- Therefore, <u>ODEO</u> is proposing to calculate contract specific <u>MCUB goals</u>

MCUB Contracts — Setting Goals

- At time of CIM, contracts that meet MCUB Program criteria will go through a MCUB Program goal calculation step
- The goal will be calculated based on relative availability of MCUB firms
- Goal will reflect scopes of work available for subcontracting

MCUB Contracts - Administration

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ODEO Administration of MCUB contracts will mirror DBE program. For all contracts with MCUB goals ODEO will:

- Calculate and set goals
- Evaluate bid/proposals
- Monitor contracts progress reports and site visits
- Close out verify payment and address issues
- Staff resources MCUB lead & two interns

Tracking MCUB Procurements

- Track MCUB utilization on all contracts with MCUB goals
- Track procurements made to MCUB firms data will direct future recommendations
- Staff resources: MCUB lead, business analyst, .5 intern

Potential Future MCUB Phases

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 Future MCUB Program phases involve all locally funded procurements – smaller goods and services contracts

Future phases require:

- Data on procurement activity current utilization of MCUBs
- Adequate resources
- Developing the efficient mechanics of executing program

Immediate Next Steps

- A clarification of Metropolitan's Policy 3-4-6 is currently being crafted
- Policy Clarification will be reviewed by Metropolitan Council's Policies and Procedures Steering Committee
- Governor Dayton's official response expected this Spring
