**Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for closed circuit televised (CCTV) inspection of Interceptor System facilities – Southwest Area to American Environmental, LLC for their low responsive, responsible bid of \$366,972.40.

**Background**

The work of this project includes: video inspection of interceptor sewers by means of closed circuit television (CCTV). Each interceptor inspection will be performed in accordance with Pipeline Assessment Certification Program (PACP) standards. The majority of sewers in this project are located off-road, specialized equipment and non-standard techniques may be required to perform the work.

A formal, advertised Invitation for Bids was issued April 24, 2012. A total of three bids were received on May 9, 2012, ranging from the low bid of \$366,972.40 to \$1,651,050. American Environmental, LLC submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid of \$366,972.40. The engineers estimate was \$479,850.

**Rationale**

Contracts with an amount exceeding \$250,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

**Funding**

This work will be funded from the 2012 Capital Budget Project 809054.
