# TGB Program History at Metropolitan Council

- Metropolitan Council's Policy 3-4-6 explains the DBE program used for federal funded procurements (FTA & PFA)
- "For procurements not funded with federal monies, the Council does not currently have an approved small targeted group business (TGB) program in place"

# Governor Dayton's TGB initiative



- Spring of 2011 Governor Dayton requested the Metropolitan Council to re-emphasize our commitment to Targeted Group Business
- Governor Dayton references MN Department of Administration's program as preferred vehicle to accomplish goal

# Making the TGB work at the Metropolitan Council

MN Department of Administration's TGB program not a good fit with Metropolitan Council

- Preference Points Risk of lawsuit, procurement department does not support
- Economically Disadvantaged Metropolitan Council's Policies do not recognize this category
- Dept. of Admin TGB program's focus on goods and services, Metropolitan Council's program focus on construction and design projects

### TGB Program Development

- Response letter from Council Chair Haigh to Governor Dayton's office regarding TGB Program plan (attached)
- Metropolitan Council is committed to Governor Dayton's inclusion efforts
- Build on our federal DBE successes
- Multi-phase plan beginning in 2012



#### What is a Met Council TGB



- Utilizing existing certification programs no additional certification process specific to Met Council TGB
- Focused on targeting Minnesota based firms
- Continued Met Council efforts to support Minnesota Veterans

- 2 TGB Vendor Fair (Spring & Winter)
- 2 Educational Sessions "Doing Business with the Council" (Summer & Winter)
- Internal Education & Awareness Efforts Training Sessions for Met Council Buyers
- Met Council TGB Directory for internal and external use
- Resources used: TGB Lead & 1 intern

#### TGB Contracts - Criteria

TGB Goals will be put on contracts if:

- Locally funded design & construction projects over \$100,000
- Contracts have subcontracting opportunities
- There are TGB firms available to perform the work

## TGB Contracts – Setting Goals




- Met Council TGB pool is different than DBE pool
- Do not have data to support Met Councils blanket 15% DBE Goal
- TGB contracts represent a wide variety of work scopes
- Therefore, <u>ODEO is proposing to calculate contract specific</u> <u>TGB goals</u>

## TGB Contracts – Setting Goals



- At time of CIM, contracts that meet TGB criteria will go through a TGB goal calculation step
- TGB goal will be calculated based on relative availability of TGBs
- TGB goal will reflect scopes of work available for subcontracting

#### **TGB** Contracts - Administration

ODEO Administration of TGB contracts will mirror DBE program. For all contracts with TGB goals ODEO will:

- Calculate and set goals
- Evaluate bid/proposals
- Monitor contracts progress reports and site visits
- Close out verify payment and address issues
- Staff resources TGB lead & two interns

### Tracking TGB Procurements

- Track TGB utilization on all contracts with TGB goals
  - Track procurements made to TGB firms data will direct future recommendations
  - Staff resources: TGB lead, TGB business analyst, .5 intern

#### Potential Future TGB Phases

Future TGB Program phases involve all locally funded procurements – smaller goods and services contracts

Future phases require:

- Data on procurement activity current utilization of TGBs
- Adequate resources
- Developing the efficient mechanics of executing program

#### Immediate Next Steps



- A clarification of Metropolitan's Policy 3-4-6 is currently being crafted
- Policy Clarification will be reviewed by Metropolitan Council's Policies and Procedures Steering Committee
- Governor Dayton's official response expected this Spring

#### Immediate Next Steps



- Metropolitan Council's Policies and Procedures Steering Committee Approval – March 30<sup>th</sup>
- Completion of bids/proposal documents, support information – March 31<sup>st</sup>
- Eligible contracts be assigned TGB goal April 1st
- First "TGB Vendor Fair" May 15<sup>th</sup>
- First "Doing Business with the Council" Session June 10<sup>th</sup>
