### Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2007-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to move SP #82-619-14 Reconstruct Off-Road Bike Trail from FY 2008 to FY 2007 to be carried out with the mill and overlay on CSAH 19.

### Issue(s)

Washington County is planning to do a mill and overlay on CSAH 19 in FY 2007 and would like to do the bike trail reconstruction at the same time. The amendment reflects the change of cost, reduced by \$140,000 and moving the trail reconstruction from FY 2008 to FY 2007.

The fiscal balance is maintained by deferring a project. The amendment is exempt from project and regional level air conformity analysis and is consistent with the Metropolitan Council Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) adopted on December 14, 2005, with FHWA/FTA conformity determination established on February 1, 2005.
