BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: Since Minnesota received extra federal funds because no new transportation act has been passed and no high priority projects (HPP) were added, the TAB elected to distribute available formula funds to all seven counties using the 2010 State Aid allocation. Each county has selected projects that can be delivered in Fiscal Year 2011 that have no right-of-way impacts or require environmental review. This project satisfies these requirements.

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g. project in previous TIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in TIP).

Minnesota is forecasted to receive an estimated \$95 million of additional federal funds for federal fiscal year 2011 because no new authorization act has been signed. Of that \$95 million, Metro District will receive \$38.5 million. Of the \$38.5 million, \$12 million will go to the locals and \$26.5 will go to Mn/DOT trunk highway pavement projects. The \$12 million will be divided between the eight metro area counties. Distribution of these funds to each county is based on formula used to distribute the 2010 State Aid allocation. For Ramsey County, the amount received is \$1,770,300.

Ramsey County has identified a concrete rehabilitation project, project 62-665-049, to utilize the additional federal funds. The project includes:

- · Joint repair,
- Diamond grinding,
- Upgrade all pedestrian ramps to ADA standards,
- Upgrade all traffic signals with Audible Pedestrian Signals, and
- Install durable pavement markings, including crosswalks.

This amendment is needed to add this project in SFY 2011 of the 2011-2014 TIP.


